WHEREAS, the Greater Holy Temple Church has submitted its petition for a Special Use Permit to allow the said church to construct a new church auditorium on two lots owned by the said church at 1405 West Dublin, Urbana, Illinois, and zoned R-2 (Single Family Residential), and

WHEREAS, the Urbana Plan Commission has considered the said petition after due notice and public hearing thereon, in Plan Case #1234-SU-86, and

WHEREAS, the Urbana Plan Commission has recommended approval of the requested Special Use Permit, subject to certain conditions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE URBANA CITY COUNCIL, that:

1. A Special Use Permit is hereby granted to the petition, Greater Holy Temple Church, to use the property commonly known as 1405 West Dublin, Urbana, Illinois for church purposes, subject to the conditions set forth in paragraph 2 below, the said property being legally described as:

Lots 5 and 6 in Block 22 of the Seminary Addition to the City of Urbana, Champaign County, Illinois. Also includes Lots 1, 2, 3 and 4 in Block 22 of the Seminary Addition to the City of Urbana, Champaign County, Illinois.

- 2. The following conditions are imposed upon the Special Use Permit herein granted:
 - (a) That the site, if improved with a church, be improved in accord with the site plan attached as Exhibit "A";
 - (b) That the drive on the west parking lot as shown in attached Exhibit "B" be removed and closed to traffic; and
 - (c) That parking lots and alleys shall be paved to their full widths as shown in attached Exhibit "C", to be approved by the City of Urbana Community Development Services Department.

- 3. The following waivers are herein granted:
- (a) The requirement of Section VII 6(I)(2) of the Urbana Zoning Ordinance requiring a 6 foot high chain link fence is hereby waived;
- The 25 foot side and rear yard requirements of Section VII (b) 6(I)(3) are waived and in their place are established the R-2 (Single Family Residential) side and rear yard restrictions.
- 4. If the Special Use herein granted is not established within two years of the date of passage of this Ordinance, the Special Use shall lapse and be held for naught.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with the terms of Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.




SITE PLAN


SITE PLAN
