

ORDINANCE NO. 8687-5

AN ORDINANCE
AMENDING SECTION 2-99 OF THE
CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That subsection (a) of Section 2-99, entitled "Civil service system", of Chapter 2, entitled "Administration", of the Code of Ordinances, City of Urbana, Illinois, be and the same is hereby amended by adding a new part (3) thereto, which such new part (3) shall provide as follows:

(3) Persons who have attained their 35th birthday shall not be disqualified from taking an examination for a position as a firefighter or a police officer in the classified service of the City of Urbana solely on the grounds of such specified limitation as to having attained their 35th birthday.

Section 2. That this Ordinance shall apply to all examinations for a position as a firefighter or a police officer in the classified service of the City of Urbana to be made from and after the effective date of this Ordinance.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council.
