

ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN TERRITORY  
TO THE CITY OF URBANA

WHEREAS, the hereinafter described territory is situated in unincorporated territory adjacent to and contiguous to the City of Urbana, Illinois, and is not part of any fire protection district, and no township road right-of-way is involved, and

WHEREAS, a written Petition signed by all of the owners of Record and more than 51% of the electors residing therein, of all land within such territory, has been filed with the City Clerk of the City of Urbana, Illinois, requesting annexation thereof to the City of Urbana, and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that said Petition complies with all requirements of the law therefor, and

WHEREAS, the majority of the Members of the Council are of the opinion that it would be for the best interests of the People of the City of Urbana, Illinois, that said territory be annexed to and made a part of the said City,

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

Section 1. That the following described real estate, viz:

The East Half of the Southwest Quarter of Section 20, Township 19 North, Range 9 East of the Third Principal Meridian, encompassing 80 Acres, more or less, excluding 3.15 Acres of previously annexed Right-of-Way, situated in Champaign County, State of Illinois,

commonly known for reference as Orchard Downs Married Student Apartments, Urbana, Illinois, be and the same is hereby annexed to the City of Urbana, Illinois. The above-described parcel, prior to annexation, has the permanent index numbers part of 30-21-20-100-003 and part of 30-21-20-300-001, and following annexation the said parcel will bear the permanent index numbers -21-20-100-003 and part of -21-20-300-001.

Section 2. That the City Clerk be authorized and directed to file for record a certified copy of this Ordinance together with an accurate map of the territory hereinabove described in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds for Champaign County, Illinois.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from after its passage and recording as provided by law.

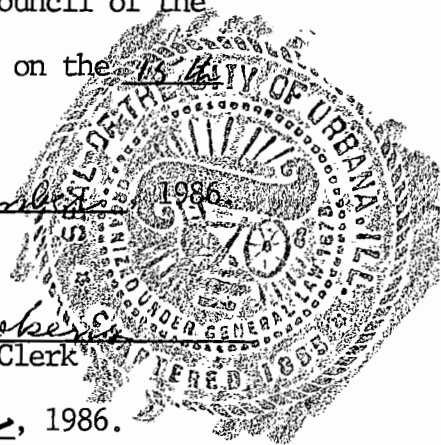

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
