ORDINANCE NO. 8687-61

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE INSTALLATION OF SANITARY SEWERS IN A PORTION OF IOWA STREET

(IOWA STREET SANITARY SEWER PROJECT - CITY SECTION NUMBER 86-00253-LI-SR)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. A local improvement shall be constructed in the City of Urbana consisting of:

610 lineal feet of 8-inch diameter sanitary sewer main, 114 lineal feet of 6-inch diameter sanitary sewer service pipe with associated wyes, bends, plugs and transition gaskets, four 48-inch diameter sanitary manholes, 745 cubic yards of granular trench backfill, removal and replacement of bituminous aggregate pavement,

as shown on the plans dated the 22nd day of December, 1986 and approved by the Board of Local Improvements.

That it is not necessary to acquire any property, public or private, for the installation of the said sewers in accordance with the said plans.

Section 2. Said improvement shall consist of sanitary sewer pipes, connections and manholes, all as set forth in the estimate of costs hereto attached and incorporated herein by reference and shall include backfill of trenches with appropriate materials and the regrading of topsoil as necessary. City Datum for the purpose of this improvement is fixed and established as the official datum of the United States Geological Survey.

All materials of every kind and character to be used in the construction of this improvement shall be first class quality, suitable for the purpose for which they are to be used, and subject to the inspection and approval of the Board of Local Improvements of the City of Urbana, Champaign County, Illinois.

All work shall be constructed in a workmanlike manner under the superintendence of the Board of Local Improvements of the City of Urbana, Illinois.

All construction methods and materials used in construction of the improvement herein provided for shall conform with the requirements of the "Standard Specifications for Water and Sewer Main Construction in Illinois", Third Edition, adopted by the Illinois Society of Professional Engineers and the Association of General Contractor in Illinois, in May, 1986 and the "Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction" prepared by the Department of Transportation, State of Illinois, and adopted by said department on October 1, 1983, and the special provisions prepared by the Urbana Engineering Department, copies of which are on file with the City Engineer of the City of Urbana.

The quantities and types of materials to be used are as set forth in the estimate of cost attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 3. The recommendation of the Board of Local Improvements, the estimate of cost thereof and the plans, being the same plans as referred to in Section 1, all hereto attached and incorporated herein by reference, be and the same are hereby, approved.

Section 4. That said improvements shall be made and the cost thereof, which is estimated to be \$60,096.00, shall be apportioned as follows: \$4,567.40 shall be paid for by a special assessment against the properties abutting on said improvement, all in accordance with Article 9, Division 2 of Chapter 24 of the Illinois Municipal Code, and the remainder of the costs shall be paid by the City of Urbana from sewer benefit tax receipts, if the Commissioner to spread the assessment agrees with the above apportionment of public and private benefits. Should the said Commissioner

disagree with such apportionment of the public and private benefits, then and in that event, the said improvements shall not be made until this Council resolves to proceed with the said improvements in accordance with the public and private benefits so determined by the said Commissioner.

Section 5. The aggregate amount herein ordered to be assessed and each individual assessment shall be divided into ten (10) installments which shall bear interest at the rate of nine percent (9%) per annum until paid, all in the manner and in accordance with the provisions of the aforesaid Article 9, Division 2 of Chapter 24 of the Illinois Municipal Code.

Section 6. Each of the lots, parcels and tracts benefited by this improvement and against which special assessments are levied may be granted by the City Engineer, based upon good engineering judgment, the right to not connect to the sanitary sewer so installed pursuant to this Ordinance, for a period of ten (10) years from the acceptance of said sewer by the City Engineer; nor shall any connection or inspection fees of any kind be charged to the owners of such parcels for their initial connection to the said sanitary sewer.

Section 7. Jeffrey T. Markland, Mayor of the City of Urbana, Illinois, is designated as the person to file a petition in the Circuit Court of Champaign County, Illinois, as provided by law in the name of the City of Urbana, Illinois, to ascertain what property will be benefited by said improvement and the amount of such benefit and also that steps be taken to levy a special assessment for said improvement in accordance with the provisions of this Ordinance and in the manner prescribed by law.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and recording as provided by law.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called of a majority of the Members of the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council.

That there be considered the construction of local improvement consisting of 610 lineal feet of 8-inch diameter sanitary sewer main, 114 lineal feet of a 6-inch diameter sanitary service pipe with associated tees, bends, and plugs, four 48-inch diameter sanitary manholes, 745 cubic yards of granular trench backfill, removal and replacement of bituminous aggregate pavement according to the plans for the Iowa Street Sanitary Sewers, City Section 86-00253-LI-SR, prepared and reviewed by the Urbana Public Engineer.

Section 2. The Construction of the proposed improvement will not require the taking or damaging of any property because all work is to be performed on the City right-of-way.

That the said proposed improvement as originally described in the Resolution passed by this Board on the 11th day of December, 1986, and the estimate of cost of said improvement and the plans attached hereto be approved, and be adhered to and that the City of Urbana, Illinois proceed with such improvement and that this Board submit to the governing body of the City of Urbana, Illinois its

recommendation that the proposed improvement be made together with an Ordinance theretofore and estimate of cost thereof as prescribed by law, and that this Board hereby approves the proposed draft of an Ordinance attached hereto providing for such an improvement.
