

ORDINANCE NO. 8687-75

AN ORDINANCE
AMENDING SECTION 4-19 OF THE
CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

That Section 4-19, entitled "Disposition of impounded dogs", of Chapter 4, entitled "Animals and Fowl", of the Code of Ordinances, City of Urbana, Illinois, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Any dog impounded as provided in this article may be redeemed by the owner or keeper of such dog upon payment of eight dollars (\$8.00) per day to the city collector for the care and feeding of such dog for each day or part of a day that it has been impounded. In case of any dog so impounded which has not been vaccinated against rabies, the impounder shall notify the county rabies control; giving the name and address of the owner. Any dog impounded as provided in this article not redeemed within seven (7) days after being impounded shall be disposed of in a manner consistent with the laws of the state.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council.
