

ORDINANCE NO. 8687-76

AN ORDINANCE
FIXING THE FEE FOR GOING OUT OF BUSINESS SALES

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois requires a license for a going out of business sale in Section 157.8 of Chapter 121 1/2 "Sales"; and

WHEREAS, effective January 1, 1987, the state statute has changed the provisions therein regarding the fee to be charged for such license or renewal of such and presently requires that a fee of "no more than \$75.00 shall accompany an application of a license and for renewal of a license."

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

That the fee to be charged by the Urbana City Clerk for each going out of business license or renewal thereof pursuant to Section 157.8 of Chapter 121 1/2 "Sales" of the Illinois Revised Statutes 1985 is hereby fixed in the amount of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00).

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council.
