

ORDINANCE NO. 8687-94

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING A SPECIAL USE PERMIT

WHEREAS, the First Wesleyan Church has submitted its petition for a Special Use Permit to allow the said church to construct a new church on real estate owned by the said church at 406 East Illinois Street, Urbana, Illinois, and zoned R-3 (Single and Two Family Residential), and

WHEREAS, the Urbana Plan Commission has considered the said petition after due notice and public hearing thereon, in Plan Case #1238-SU-86, and

WHEREAS, the Urbana Plan Commission has recommended approval of the requested Special Use Permit, subject to certain conditions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE URBANA CITY COUNCIL, that:

1. A special Use Permit is hereby granted to the petitioner, First Wesleyan Church, to use the property commonly known as 406 East Illinois Street, Urbana, Illinois for church purposes, subject to the conditions set forth in paragraph 2 below, the said property being legally described as:

Lots 4 & 5 of Block 3 of Webber's Second Addition to the City of Urbana, Champaign County, Illinois, situated in the City of Urbana, Champaign County, Illinois,

bearing permanent parcel numbers 92-21-17-234-005, 92-21-17-243-008 and 92-21-17-243-009.

2. The following conditions are imposed upon the Special Use Permit herein granted:

AN ORDINANCE  
APPROVING THE ANNUAL BUDGET

WHEREAS, the City of Urbana, Illinois, is a home rule unit pursuant to the provisions of Section 6, Article VII of the 1970 Constitution of the State of Illinois, and may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs, including, but not limited to, the power to regulate for the protection of the public health, safety, morals and welfare; to license; to tax; and to incur debt; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Annual Budget for the City of Urbana for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1987 and ending June 30, 1988 has been prepared by the Budget Director in accordance with the provisions of Division 2, entitled "Budget", of Article VI, entitled "Finances and Purchases", of Chapter 2, entitled "Administration", of the Code of Ordinances, City of Urbana, Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Annual Budget was made conveniently available for public inspection by the Mayor at least fourteen (14) days prior to a public hearing on said proposed Annual Budget duly held at 7:15 P.M. on Monday, June 8, 1987, after due and proper notice of the availability for inspection of the proposed Annual Budget and the said public hearing having been given by publication in the News-Gazette, a newspaper having a general circulation in the City of Urbana on May 21, 1987, a date at least fourteen (14) days prior to the date of said public hearing; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, hereby desires to pass, approve and adopt the proposed Annual Budget as heretofore further changed, modified and amended by the City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

That the City of Urbana Budget 1987-88, a complete copy of which such document including all relevant elements thereof has been presented to and is now before this meeting, be and the same is hereby passed, approved and adopted as the Annual Budget Ordinance of and for the City of Urbana, Champaign County, Illinois, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1987 and ending June 30, 1988.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council.
