

ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN TERRITORY
TO THE CITY OF URBANA

WHEREAS, the hereinafter described territory is situated in unincorporated territory adjacent to and contiguous to the City of Urbana, Illinois, and is part of the Carroll Fire Protection District and includes certain Highways within the Urbana Township, and Notice was given to the Trustees of said Fire Protection District, the Board of Township Trustees, and the Township Commissioner of Highways, said notices being mailed on October 21, 1987, that this Ordinance would be voted upon at the regular meeting of this Council at 7:30 P.M., Monday, November 2, 1987, and the Affidavit of mailing such Notices was duly recorded with the Recorder of Deeds of Champaign County, Illinois on the 28th day of October, 1987, and

WHEREAS, a written Petition signed by all of the owners of Record of all land within such territory, has been filed with the City Clerk of the City of Urbana, Illinois, requesting annexation thereof to the City of Urbana, and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that said Petition complies with all requirements of the law therefor, and

WHEREAS, the majority of the Members of the Council are of the opinion that it would be for the best interests of the People of the City of Urbana, Illinois, that said territory be annexed to and made a part of the said City.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

Section 1. That the following described real estate, viz:

Tract 3: Lots 6 and 7 of Reinhold Acres in Champaign County, Illinois as per Plat recorded in Plat Book "M" at Page 34, at the Office of the Champaign County Recorder of Deeds, situated in Champaign County, Illinois, encompassing 0.77 acres, more or less;

Together with the adjacent 200' x 60' portion of Willow Road right-of-way, encompassing 0.28 Acres, more or less;

All situated in Champaign County, Illinois,

commonly known for reference as 2008 and 2010 North Willow Road, Urbana, Illinois, be and the same is hereby annexed to the City of Urbana, Illinois.

Section 2. That the City Clerk be authorized and directed to file for record a certified copy of this Ordinance together with an accurate map of the territory hereinabove described in the Office of the Recorder of Deeds for Champaign County, Illinois.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and recording as provided by law.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called of a majority of the Members of the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council on the 2nd day of November, 1987.
