

ORDINANCE NO. 8788-42

AN ORDINANCE
AMENDING THE URBANA LOCAL TRAFFIC ORDINANCE, AS AMENDED

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That Schedule IX of Section 14-3, entitled "Parking Prohibited at all Times on Certain Streets", of Article XIV of the Urbana Local Traffic Ordinance, as amended, be and the same is hereby further amended by adding to that schedule the following portions of streets where parking shall be prohibited at any time:

| <u>Street</u> | | <u>Side of Street</u> |
|---------------|--|-----------------------|
| Iowa Street | Westbound from 260 feet to 220 feet east from the centerline of Vine Street | North |
| Iowa Street | The dead end portion thereof approximately 30 feet wide located 220 feet east of the centerline of Vine Street | West |
| Springfield | Westbound from Cedar Street to Birch Street | North |

Section 2. That Schedule XII, pursuant to Section 14-11, entitled "Tow-Away Zones", of Article XIV, entitled "Stopping, Standing or Parking Restricted or Prohibited On Certain Streets", of the Urbana Local Traffic Ordinance, as amended, be and the same is hereby further amended by adding to that schedule the following portions of streets which shall be established as tow-away zones:

| <u>Street</u> | <u>From</u> | <u>To</u> | <u>Side of Street</u> |
|---------------|--|-----------|-----------------------|
| Iowa Street | 220 feet to 260 feet east of the centerline of Vine Street | | North and South |
| Iowa Street | The dead end portion thereof approximately 30 feet wide located 220 feet east of the centerline of Vine Street | | West |

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council.
