

ORDINANCE NO. 8788-52

AN ORDINANCE
AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES TO PROVIDE
FOR A SERVICE CHARGE FOR INSUFFICIENT FUNDS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

That Chapter 1, entitled "General Provisions", of the
Code of Ordinances, City of Urbana, Illinois, be and the same is
hereby amended by adding to such chapter a new section 1-16, to
be entitled and to provide as follows:

Sec. 1-16. Service charge for check returned for
insufficient funds.

Any person who tenders a check or other order to the
city in payment of or for a permit, license, fee, fine, tax or
service as required by this code or otherwise by law, which check
or other order is not then paid by the depository because of any
failure to have sufficient funds or credit with the depository
when the check or other order is presented to the depository for
payment, is subject to a service charge payable to the city in
the amount of ten dollars (\$10.00).

This ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative
vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the
members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a
regular meeting of said council.
