## ORDINANCE NO. 8788-54

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE URBANA LOCAL TRAFFIC ORDINANCE, AS AMENDED

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That Section 14.13, entitled "Parking Permits", of Article XIV, entitled "Stopping, Standing or Parking Restricted on Certain Streets", of the Urbana Local Traffic Ordinance be and the same is hereby amended by revising subsection (a) as follows:

(a) Unless otherwise specifically provided for by other parking prohibitions, on each street in the area bounded by (but not including) Green and Race Streets, Lincoln and Florida Avenue (hereinafter called "the area"), parking on that side of the street where parking is not prohibited at all times shall be prohibited between 3:00 A.M. and 10:00 A.M., except for those vehicles displaying a valid permit issued pursuant to subsections (b), (c) or (d) below. The foregoing parking prohibitions of this subsection shall not be operative on Saturdays, Sundays, or City legal holidays.

Section 2. That Schedule X, entitled "Parking Prohibited During Certain Hours on Certain Days", of Section 14-4, entitled "Parking Prohibited During Certain Hours on Certain Streets", of Article XIV, entitled "Stopping, Standing or Parking Restricted on Certain Streets", of the Urbana Local Traffic Ordinance, as amended, be and the same is hereby further amended by adding to that Schedule X the following portion of a street where parking shall be prohibited between the hours of 3:00 A.M. to 1:00 P.M. on Monday through and including Friday of each week, except City legal holidays:

Street From To Side of Street

Garfield Indiana Dead end between East Indiana and Iowa

This ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said council.
