First violation, as used herein, shall mean a violation when the defendant has no previous violation within a period of one hundred eighty (180) days last past prior to the date of the violation. Second violation, as used herein, shall mean a violation when the defendant has one previous violation within a period of one hundred eighty (180) days last past prior to the date of the violation. Additional violation, as used herein, shall mean a violation when the defendant has two (2) or more previous violations within a period of one hundred eighty (180) days last past prior to the date of the violation. Section 2. That Section 4-36, entitled "Disposition of impounded cats", of Chapter 4, entitled "Animals and Fowl", of the Code of Ordinances, City of Urbana, Illinois, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows: Sec. 4-36. Disposition of impounded cats. Any cat impounded as provided in section 4-35 may, to the extent permitted by the laws or regulations of this state and of the local public health district, be redeemed by the owner or keeper of such cat upon payment of eight dollars (\$8.00) per day to the city collector for the care and feeding of such cat for each day or part of a day that it has been impounded. Any cat impounded as provided in section 4-35 not redeemed within seven (7) days after being impounded may be disposed of in a manner consistent with the laws of this state. This ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said council. - 1 -

Any cat impounded as provided in section 4-35 may, to the extent permitted by the laws or regulations of this state and of the local public health district, be redeemed by the owner or keeper of such cat upon payment of eight dollars (\$8.00) per day to the city collector for the care and feeding of such cat for each day or part of a day that it has been impounded. Any cat impounded as provided in section 4-35 not redeemed within seven (7) days after being impounded may be disposed of in a menner consistent with the laws of this state.
