

ORDINANCE REGARDING NOTICE OF REFUNDS
WITH RESPECT TO COIN OPERATED MACHINES

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE URBANA CITY COUNCIL OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that

Section 1. That all coin operated machines made available for the use of the general public shall have firmly affixed to them, or as otherwise provided in this Ordinance, a permanent and legible sign or sticker containing the following information.

- A. The full name of the owner of the coin operated machine, if such person is different than such person listed in "B" below.
- B. The name, address, and telephone number identifying the person(s) who are authorized to make refunds from the malfunctioning of the machine.

Section 2. The telephone number provided in "B" above shall be a telephone number that would not require a toll call if a call were made from the same premises whereon the coin operated machine is located.


Section 3. Either the sign or sticker shall be displayed within 12 inches of the slot where coins are to be inserted to operate the machine, or a sign measuring a minimum of 12 inches by 6 inches shall be posted within 3 feet of such coin operated machine in a manner that makes such sign visible to the user of the machine.

Section 4. Both the owner of the premises whereon a coin operated machine is located and the owner of the coin operated machine shall be responsible to insure that this Ordinance is complied with.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage in accordance with the terms of Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called of a majority of the Members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council on the 7th day of August, 1989.
