

ORDINANCE NO. 8990-2

AN ORDINANCE
AMENDING SECTION 3-46 OF THE
CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

That Section 3-46, entitled "Issuance to business selling motor fuel", of Chapter 3, entitled "Alcoholic Liquors", of the Code of Ordinances, City of Urbana, Illinois, as amended, be and the same is hereby further amended by the following:


1. Repealing and deleting all of subsection (c) thereof, which provides as follows:

(c) Provided further, however, no license for the sale of alcoholic liquor shall be issued to a person to sell alcoholic liquor on the same premises where, as part of the business conducted, such person sells or offers for sale any motor fuel, if such premises are zoned B-1 (neighborhood business).

2. Redesignating subsections (d) and (e) thereof as subsections (c) and (d), respectively.

This ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a special meeting of said City Council.
