

AN ORDINANCE
REGARDING STREET NAMES WILLOW ROAD, KENYON ROAD

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 11-80-19 of the Illinois Municipal Code, (the "Code"), the corporate authorities of the City of Urbana, Illinois may change the name of any street, avenue, alley or other public place, such change to be effective after notice as therein further provided; and

WHEREAS, the County of Champaign, by action of the County Board's Environment and Land Use Committee on the 13th day of April, 1989, renamed a road previously named Reinhold Drive and officially designated it as "Willow Road"; and

WHEREAS, the County of Champaign, by action of the County Board's Environment and Land Use Committee on the 4th day of May, 1989, renamed a road previously named Faith Drive and officially designated it as "Kenyon Road"; and

WHEREAS, to avoid confusion it is deemed in the best interests of the City of Urbana to make the following street name designations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That the following described public road right-of-way, to-wit: That portion of Township Road 1400E, formerly known as Reinhold Drive within the corporate limits of the City of Urbana, Illinois; be and the same is hereby named Willow Road, and that the following described public road right-of-way, to-wit: That portion of a segment of the I-74 frontage road, formerly known as Faith Drive within the corporate limits of the City of Urbana, Illinois; be and the same is hereby named Kenyon Road, all as further depicted upon a map attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. That the City Clerk be and the same is hereby directed to provide certified copies of this Ordinance to the County Clerk of Champaign County, Illinois, the election authority having jurisdiction in the area in which the name of the streets are changed, and to the Urbana branch of the U.S. Postal Service, the post office branch serving such area, by sending such certified copies by certified or registered mail.

Section 3. That pursuant to the Code, such name changes of streets as made and provided for in this Ordinance shall not be effective until thirty (30) days after said election authority and post office branch have been so notified by the corporate authority as provided in Section 2 hereof.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the

members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council.

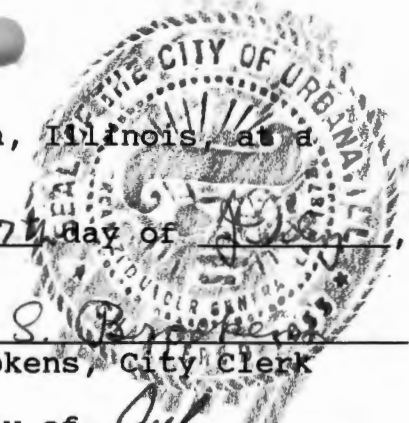

Section 2. That the City Clerk be and the same is hereby directed to provide certified copies of this Ordinance to the County Clerk of Champaign County, Illinois, the election authority having jurisdiction in the area in which the name of the streets are changed, and to the Urbana branch of the U.S. Postal Service, the post office branch serving such area, by sending such certified copies by certified or registered mail.

Section 3. That pursuant to the Code, such name changes of streets as made and provided for in this Ordinance shall not be effective until thirty (30) days after said election authority and post office branch have been so notified by the corporate authority as provided in Section 2 hereof.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the

members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council.

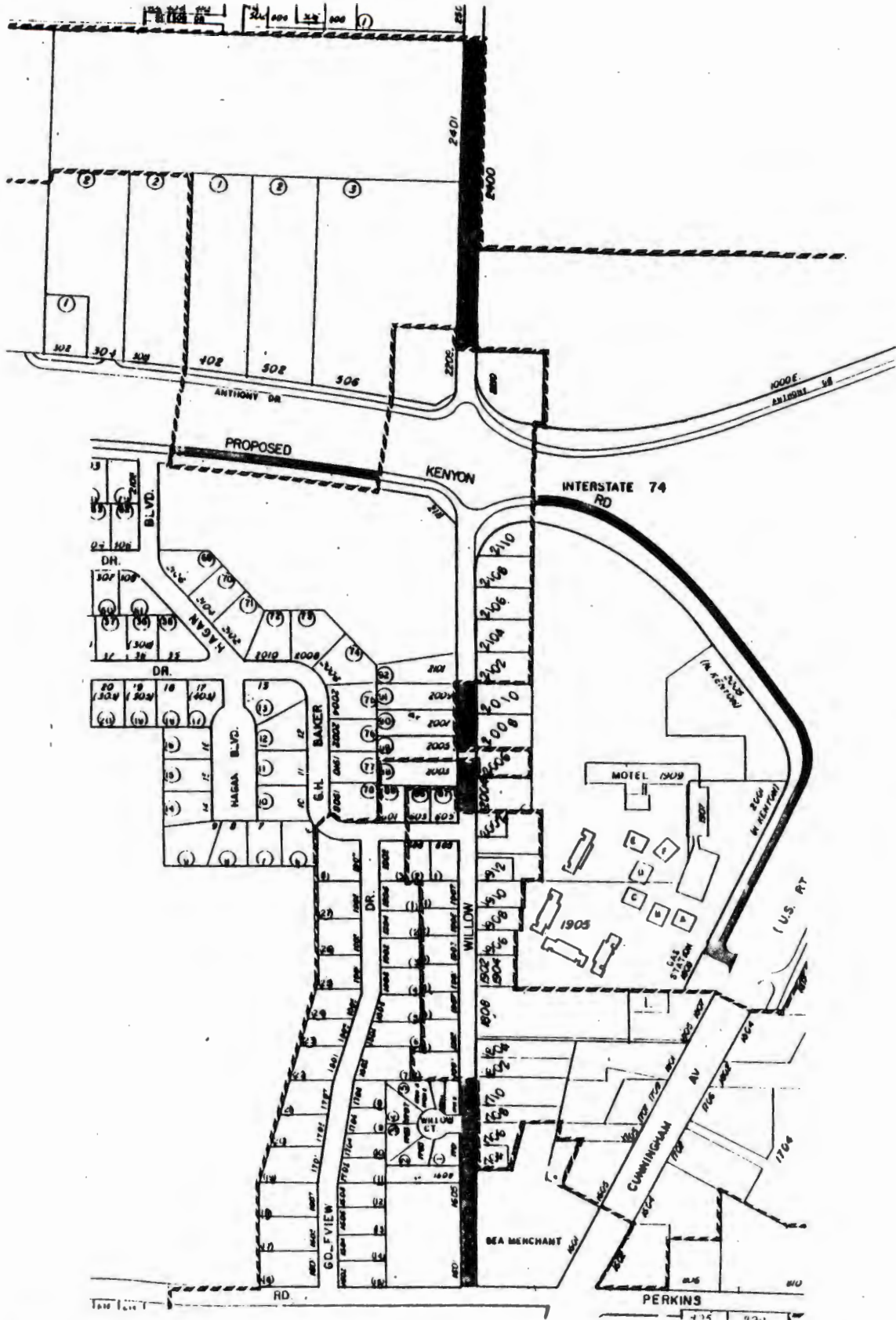
