

ORDINANCE NO. 8990-104

AN ORDINANCE
AUTHORIZING THE EXCHANGE OF AN ITEM OF PERSONAL
PROPERTY OWNED BY THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the City of Urbana, Illinois (the "City"), owns the following item of personal property, to-wit: one 1959 American-LaFrance, Mod-Metro 900 Series N-695, which such item has been determined to be of no further use to the City of Urbana, Illinois, by the department head previously utilizing such item; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that such item is no longer necessary or useful to, or for the best interests of the City of Urbana to retain.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That the aforesaid item of personal property is hereby authorized to be transferred and delivered to The Illinois Fire Service Institute (the "Institute") in exchange for such instructional services as are specified in an Agreement between the Institute and the City dated as of March 7, 1990 (the "Agreement"), a copy of which is attached hereto and hereby incorporated by reference. The proper officers of the City are hereby authorized and empowered to execute and deliver the Agreement and to effect the exchange in accordance with the terms of the Agreement.

Section 2. This ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of three-fourths (3/4ths) of the members of the corporate authorities of the City of Urbana, then holding office.
