

ORDINANCE NO. 9091-37

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 10  
ENTITLED "GARBAGE AND REFUSE" OF THE URBANA CITY CODE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA,  
ILLINOIS, that:

Section 1. Article I, Section 10-1, Subsection (a) of the Urbana City Code, is hereby amended to add the following definitions upon taking effect of this Ordinance:

"**Landscape Waste.** All accumulations of grass or shrubbery cuttings, leaves, tree limbs and other materials accumulated as a result of the care of lawns, shrubbery, vines and trees.

**City Container.** U-Bags and/or U-Ties, or any other means of containment approved by the City Council."

Section 2. Article I, Section 10-1, Subsection (b) is hereby repealed in its entirety and the following is enacted in its place upon taking effect of this Ordinance:

"Section 10-1(b).

No person shall throw, discharge or deposit in any place within the City any garbage, animal matter, dead animals, or other refuse, rubbish or debris of any kind, except in receptacles made of impervious materials having a solid bottom and tight-fitting lid which are stored and located on private property other than that owned or controlled by the City, including the city right-of-way and other than the front yard of such private property. The above provisions shall not apply, however, to persons temporarily storing food cans, glass bottles, newspapers, plastic containers, or any other recyclable material for collection by the City or its authorized agent on such private property or adjacent parkway where such recyclable materials are generated on or collected from the same premises where stored and are in containers approved by the City or otherwise packaged as approved by the City. This section shall not apply to landscape waste which is placed in compliance with Section 10-7."

Section 3. Article I, Section 10-7, is repealed in its entirety and the following enacted in its place upon the taking effect of this Ordinance:

"Sec. 10-7. Placing grass, leaves or debris in streets and gutters.

(a) It shall be unlawful for any person to place grass, leaves or other debris in the streets or gutters of the City.

(b) Landscape waste can be temporarily stored for a maximum of seven (7) days on private property or City right-of-way, adjacent to where such landscape waste is generated from, that are in bundles, containers or bags that each bear a landscape waste collection sticker which complies with Section 10-8, or that are in City containers.

(c) No landscape waste shall be stacked, piled or otherwise placed on the public right-of-way so that the height of such stack exceeds three feet (3'), nor shall any landscape waste be placed within the visibility triangle as defined in Section 20-83 of the Urbana City Code."

Section 4. Article I of the Urbana City Code is hereby amended to add a new Section 10-8, as follows upon the taking effect of this Ordinance:

"Sec. 10-8. Identification of landscape waste

Landscape waste collection sticker is a tag or sticker complying with the following:

(a) such sticker is a minimum of twelve (12) square inches

(b) is distinctive in color

(c) has the name, address and phone number in permanent ink of the person and/or company who has contracted to collect such

(d) must clearly state that it is intended for private collection by the person and/or company identified in Section 10-8(c) and will not be collected by the City's program."

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with the terms of Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called of a majority of the Members of the

City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council on the 17th day of September, 1990.
