

AN ORDINANCE
ABOLISHING THE OFFICE OF PUBLIC SAFETY DIRECTOR

WHEREAS, it has been found conducive to the public health and safety that the office of public safety director shall be replaced by the offices of chief of police and chief of the fire department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, that Division 5 of Article III of Chapter 2 of the City of Urbana Code of Ordinances is hereby repealed and in its place is enacted the following:

Section 1.

DIVISION 5. CHIEF OF POLICE

Sec. 2-72. Office Established.

The office of chief of police is hereby established.

Sec. 2-73. Duties

All of the provisions of law and of this Code relating to the powers and duties of the chief of police or any other similar term relating to such position shall be exercised and performed by the chief of police.

DIVISION 6. CHIEF OF THE FIRE DEPARTMENT

Sec. 2-74. Office Established.

The office of chief of the fire department is hereby established.

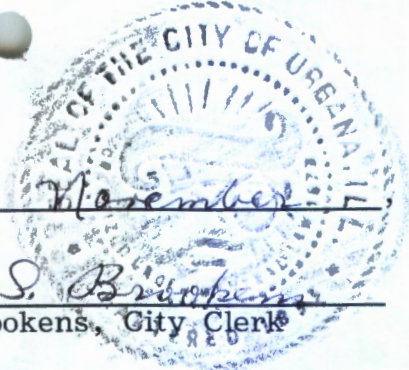
Sec. 2-75. Duties.

All of the provisions of law and of this Code relating to the powers and duties of the chief of the fire department or any other similar term relating to such position shall be exercised and performed by the chief of the fire department.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from its passage and recording as provided by law.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the Members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of the said Council on the 19th day of November, 1990.
