

ORDINANCE NO. 9091-83

**AN AMENDMENT TO THE ZONING ORDINANCE  
OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS**

**(IN Industrial District)**

(Plan Case #1423-T-90 - Request to Amend the  
IN Industrial District)

WHEREAS, after due publication, a public hearing before the Urbana Plan Commission was held on February 7, 1991, concerning the petition filed in Plan Case 1423-T-90; and

WHEREAS, the Urbana Plan Commission recommended approval of the request that Article V, Table V-1 of the Urbana Zoning Ordinance be changed to include "Professional and Business Office" and "Photographic Studio and Equipment Sales and Service" as principal uses permitted by right in the Industrial (IN) District.

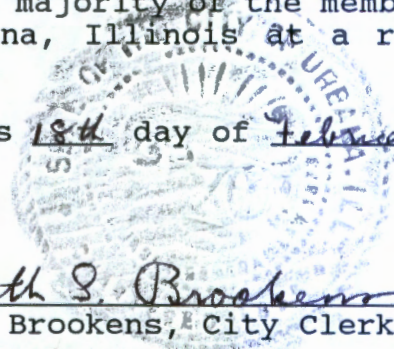
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, THAT:

The Zoning Ordinance of the City of Urbana is herewith and hereby amended to change Article V, Table V-1 to include "Professional and Business Office" and "Photographic Studio and Equipment Sales and Service" as principal uses permitted by right (P) in the Industrial (IN) District.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with the terms of Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and the "nays" being called of a majority of the members of the City Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois at a regular meeting of said Council.
