ORDINANCE NO. 9091-116

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING CERTAIN METER ZONES ON STOUGHTON, MAIN, CLARK AND HARVEY STREETS

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 17-1 of The Urbana Local Traffic Ordinance, the Mayor of the City of Urbana has authorized and directed the establishment of the following parking meter zones upon the following streets, to-wit: both sides of Street, Main Street and Clark Street between Mathews and Harvey Streets and both sides of Harvey Street between Springfield and University Avenue, and herewith presents such establishment of such meter zones for the approval of the City Council.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED:

Section 1. That the Urbana City Council herewith and hereby approves the establishment of such parking meter zones.

Section 2. The Director of Public Works is directed to establish and erect meters with the appropriate spacing to permit parking on such streets where parking is not otherwise prohibited, so that if that person deposits coins in such meters to allow that person to park in the space for the duration allowed by Ordinance and/or the duration permitted by the coins inserted, whichever is shorter.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with the terms of Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council.
