

ORDINANCE NO. 9091-123

AN ORDINANCE  
EXCUSING THE REQUIREMENT FOR BIDS

WHEREAS, Section 2-115 of the Code of Ordinances, City of Urbana, Illinois, provides that all contracts for the purchase of supplies or equipment requiring an expenditure of a sum in excess of \$2,500.00 shall be advertised for bids and let to the lowest responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, to implement certain parking regulations heretofore authorized by the Urbana City Council in a timely manner it is necessary to proceed with the purchase of certain parking meter devices on a negotiated price basis rather than through a bidding process.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

1) parking meter devices from a vendor thereof at a purchase price of not to exceed \$82,000.00, which such amount has been previously budgeted for the same;

such purchase to be without the requirement to advertise for bids and let such purchase contract to the lowest responsible bidder as required by said Section 2-115 of the code of Ordinances.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council.
