

ORDINANCE NO. 9091-127

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY ENGINEER
TO ACCEPT DEDICATIONS ON BEHALF OF THE CITY

WHEREAS, from time to time the City of Urbana finds it necessary to acquire dedications of right-of-way and permanent easements in connection with public improvements undertaken by the City; and

WHEREAS, such dedications and permanent easements are acquired in conjunction with public improvements authorized by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable to establish an orderly process to formally accept such dedications and easements.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Urbana City Council as follows:

Section 1. For all dedications of right-of-way and permanent easements not arising from the process of final plat approval by the City Council, the City Engineer is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Urbana all right-of-way and easement dedications necessary and beneficial to the City of Urbana.

Section 2. Such acceptance shall consist of the signature of the City Engineer on the deed of dedication, and shall be effective upon recording of the deed and any required supporting documents.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative votes, the ayes and nays being called, the majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois at a regular meeting of said Council on this 20th day of May, 1991.
