AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE URBANA LOCAL TRAFFIC ORDINANCE, AS AMENDED

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That Schedule XII, entitled "Tow Away Zones," in connection with Section 14-11 of the Urbana Local Traffic Ordinance, as amended, is hereby amended by adding Rows AS1 through AS6 of the public parking area located between Vine Street and Lincoln Square to that Schedule. Vehicles parked in that area between 3:00 a.m. and 9:30 a.m. will be towed away and impounded at the owner's expense, provided that "Tow Away" signs prohibiting parking during those hours have been posted.

Section 2. That the City Traffic Engineer is hereby authorized and directed to post "Tow Away" signs in the area designated in Section 1 of this Ordinance.

Section 3. The City Clerk is directed to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council.
