## ORDINANCE NO. 9192-26

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE URBANA LOCAL TRAFFIC ORDINANCE, AS AMENDED

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. In accordance with Section 14-3 of the Urbana Local Traffic Ordinance, parking shall be prohibited at all times on both sides of Broadway Avenue between Illinois Avenue and California Avenue and Schedule IX is hereby amended to reflect this prohibition. Permanent signs are hereby ordered erected to give notice of this parking regulation.

Section 2. All ordinances, resolutions or motions, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

Section 3. The City Clerk is directed to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form by authority of the corporate authorities, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council.
