

ORDINANCE NO. 9192-37

AN ORDINANCE
REVISING THE ANNUAL BUDGET ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the Annual Budget Ordinance of and for the City of Urbana, Champaign County, Illinois, for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1991, and ending June 30, 1992, (the "Annual Budget Ordinance") has been duly adopted according to sections 8-2-9.1 et seq. of the Illinois Municipal Code (the "Municipal Code") and Division 2, entitled "Budget", of Article VI, entitled "Finances and Purchases", of Chapter 2, entitled "Administration", of the Code of Ordinances, City of Urbana, Illinois (the "City Code"); and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the said City of Urbana finds it necessary to revise said Annual Budget Ordinance by deleting, adding to, changing or creating sub-classes within object classes and object classes themselves; and

WHEREAS, funds are available to effectuate the purpose of such revision; and

WHEREAS, such revision is not one that may be made by the Budget Director under the authority so delegated to the Budget Director pursuant to section 8-2-9.6 of the Municipal Code and section 2-133 of the City Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That the Annual Budget Ordinance be and the same is hereby revised to provide as follows:

FUND: GENERAL

DEPARTMENT: FIRE		
REDUCE EXPENDITURE: Fire Chief		\$42,174
INCREASE EXPENDITURE: Asst. Fire Chief		\$ 774
DEPARTMENT: SPECIAL TRANSFERS		
ADD EXPENDITURE, Unusual Overtime		\$36,900
ADD REVENUE: Transfer from Supplementary Reserve Fund		\$36,900

FUND: SUPPLEMENTARY RESERVE

AMOUNT		\$36,900
ADD EXPENDITURE: Transfer to General Fund		
FROM: Fund Balance		

* Note: Amount for line-item unusual overtime may be transferred to, at discretion of the mayor, departments of the City to cover overtime which is occurring because of unusual events.

Section 2. Repeal of the following clause, which was added to page 140 of the City of Urbana annual budget for fiscal year 1991-92, as adopted on June 3, 1991:

"and expenditures on full time line item personnel in Fire Administration, Prevention, or Suppression shall be reduced in proportion to the length of the first full time vacancy which occurs."

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon passage and approval and shall not be published.

Section 4. This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of the corporate authorities then holding office, the "ayes" and "nays" being called at a regular meeting of said council.
