

AN ORDINANCE CLOSING AN ALLEY TO THROUGH TRAFFIC

WHEREAS, the residents owning property abutting the North/South alley from California Avenue to Illinois Street between Maple Street and Urbana Avenue have petitioned the City Council to close said alley to through traffic; and

WHEREAS, the residents are concerned for the safety of the children on the block because the alley is used as a short-cut by people who do not live on the block and who travel too fast; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is in the best interests of the City of Urbana to close the alley to through traffic by erecting an immovable barricade across the middle of the alley.

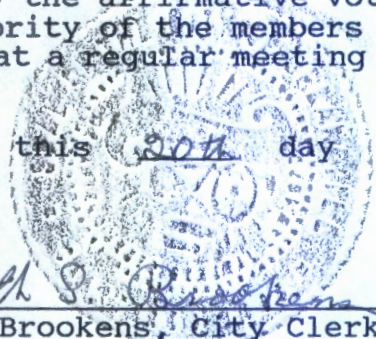
NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That the North/South alley from California Avenue to Illinois Street between Maple Street and Urbana Avenue be closed to through traffic by erecting an immovable barricade at or about the middle of the alley.

Section 2. That the closing of the alley to through traffic will not create an undue burden on traffic and will not materially impair access to any property.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois at a regular meeting of said Council.
