AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING MOTOR VEHICLE PARKING ON CERTAIN PORTIONS OF LINCOLN AVENUE IN THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois and the City of Urbana, Illinois, a municipal corporation, for improved traffic movement and public safety, contemplate an improvement of Lincoln Avenue (FAU Route 7177) from Sunset Drive to Killarney Street in said City during the calendar year 1993, in accordance with estimates, plans, maps, drawings, specifications, and contemplated agreements, and pursuant to the project designation of F.A.U. System, City Section 92-00283-00-TL, City of Urbana, Champaign County, Illinois.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

That motor vehicle parking and any parking is hereby prohibited on Lincoln Avenue in said City on both sides from Sunset Drive to Killarney Street.

The City Clerk is directed to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form by authority of the corporate authorities, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.
