## ORDINANCE NO. 9293-77

## AN ORDINANCE DISSOLVING SPECIAL SERVICE AREA NUMBER TWO

WHEREAS, Special Service Area Number Two was created by authority of Ordinance No. 7677-25 which was effective September 8, 1976 for the purpose of paying part of the costs of the construction of Local Improvement Project 186-CS, which said Local Improvement Project involved the improvement of the intersection of Philo Road and Florida Avenue, and which said Ordinance further allowed for the issuance of bonds of the City of Urbana in the amount of Two Hundred Eighty Thousand, Seven Hundred Dollars (\$280,700.00) for such purpose, payable from taxes to be levied within Special Service Area Number Two for a period of ten (10) years; and

WHEREAS, the said bonds are now fully paid and retired, and there exists no further purpose for Special Service Area Number Two.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE URBANA CITY COUNCIL THAT:

- Special Service Area Number Two as created in Ordinance NO. 7677-25 is hereby dissolved, effective immediately.
- The City Clerk is directed to send a certified copy of this Ordinance to the County Clerk of the County of Champaign, Illinois.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois at a regular meeting of said Council.
