ORDINANCE NO. 9293-112

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NOS. 9293-71, 9293-76, AND 9293-88

WHEREAS, the newly elected City Council has determined to examine the issues regarding solid waste collection and disposal within the City of Urbana;

WHEREAS, the former City Council passed Ordinance No. 9293-71, entitled "An Ordinance amending Chapters Ten and Fourteen of the Code of Ordinances, City of Urbana, Illinois regulating the collection and disposal of solid waste, the licensing of haulers, and recycling" which became effective on February 27, 1993;

WHEREAS, the former City Council passed Ordinance No. 9293-76, entitled "An Ordinance amending an Ordinance No. 9293-71, an Ordinance amending Chapters Ten and Fourteen of the Code of Ordinances, City of Urbana, Illinois regulating the collection and disposal of solid waste, the licensing of haulers, and recycling" which became effective on March 6, 1993;

WHEREAS, the former City Council passed Ordinance No. 9293-88, entitled "An Ordinance amending Chapter Ten of the Code of Ordinances, City of Urbana, Illinois regulating the collection and disposal of solid waste, the licensing of haulers, and recycling" which became effective on April 16, 1993;

WHEREAS, the newly elected City Council believes that repeal of Ordinance Nos. 9293-71, 9293-76, and 9293-88 will enable the Council to start anew in developing a solution to Urbana's solid waste collection and disposal needs;

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the City Council to repeal Ordinance Nos. 9293-71, 9293-76, and 9293-88 and to revive the ordinances that were repealed by the adoption of Ordinance Nos. 9293-71, 9293-76, and 9293-88.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 9293-71, entitled "An Ordinance amending Chapters Ten and Fourteen of the Code of Ordinances, City of Urbana, Illinois regulating the collection and disposal of solid waste, the licensing of haulers, and recycling" Ordinance No. 9293-76, entitled "An Ordinance amending an Ordinance No. 9293-71, an Ordinance amending Chapters Ten and Fourteen of the Code of Ordinances, City of Urbana, Illinois regulating the collection and disposal of solid waste, the licensing of haulers,

and recycling" and Ordinance No. 9293-88, entitled "An Ordinance amending Chapter Ten of the Code of Ordinances, City of Urbana, Illinois regulating the collection and disposal of solid waste, the licensing of haulers, and recycling" are hereby repealed and the ordinances that were repealed by the adoption of Ordinance Nos. 9293-71, 9293-76, and 9293-88 are hereby revived.

<u>Section 2.</u> All ordinances, resolutions or motions or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

Section 3. The City Clerk is directed to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form by authority of the corporate authorities, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a special meeting of said Council.
