ORDINANCE NO. 9293-123

AN ORDINANCE REGARDING PAVING OF ILLINOIS STREET BETWEEN VINE STREET AND URBANA AVENUE

WHEREAS, Illinois Street between Vine Street and Urbana Avenue is scheduled to be improved with a bituminous surface; and

WHEREAS, Section 20-68 of the Urbana City Code sets forth a requirement that existing brick pavements shall be restored to a brick pavement surface following any excavation; and

WHEREAS, the Urbana City Council finds that in this instance, it is in the best interests of the City that this portion of existing brick street not be restored to a brick pavement, but instead be paved with a concrete surface because of the frequent use thereof by fire trucks.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE URBANA CITY COUNCIL that:

The repaving of Illinois Street from Vine Street to Urbana Avenue is hereby exempt from the requirement of Section 20-68 of the Urbana City Code that such be restored to a brick paved surface.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council.
