

ORDINANCE NO. 9394-7

AN ORDINANCE REGARDING ELIGIBILITY FOR APPOINTMENT  
TO THE URBANA BUSINESS DISTRICT DEVELOPMENT AND  
REDEVELOPMENT COMMISSION

WHEREAS, the Urbana Business District Development and Redevelopment Commission was created pursuant to Ordinance 7374-70, adopted May 1, 1974, (and subsequently Amended by Ordinance 8182-37) and,

WHEREAS, the existing ordinance provisions restrict eligibility for membership on the said commission to Citizens of Urbana, and,

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the City of Urbana and its residents that eligibility should be open to all persons who have shown interest in the continued vitality of the Urbana Business District,

Now Therefore, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Urbana City Council, that ordinance 8182-37 is hereby repealed and the third sentence of section seven (7) of ordinance 7374-70 which originally created the Urbana Business District Development and Redevelopment Commission is further hereby amended to read as follows;

" The Commission shall consist of the Mayor of the City of Urbana, who shall be the Chairman of the Commission and six persons appointed by the Mayor with the advise and consent of the Council"

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the

Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of  
said Council on the 6th, day of July, 1993.
