

ORDINANCE NO. 9495-12

AN ORDINANCE RENAMING ILLINI AIRPORT ROAD

WHEREAS, the public road right-of-way commonly known as Township Road 1850N, also known as Illini Airport Road, was renamed by the County of Champaign in October, 1990 to "Airport Road" as to the portion of the said road that was not within the city limits of Urbana; and

WHEREAS, the continuous road now bears two different names, that being "Illini Airport Road" as to the portion within the city limits and "Airport Road" as to the portion that is within the County jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed to be in the best interests of the community that the continuous roadway bear a single name; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered the provisions of Section 21-40 of the Land Development Code which states as follows:

"Streets which align with or continue existing streets shall bear the name of the existing street. New street names shall not duplicate or closely resemble the names of streets already existing in Urbana, Champaign, or within one and one-half miles from either City."

; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, deems that although the public right-of-way leading to Willard Airport is also known as "Airport Road", because the two roads are so far apart, no public confusion will result.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED that the portion of Illini Airport Road that was annexed to the City of Urbana by Ordinance No. 9091-49 on October 15, 1990 and which is generally located from Willow Road to U.S. Route 45, is hereby renamed "Airport Road".

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council.
