

AN ORDINANCE REVISING THE LICENSING PROVISIONS RESPECTING  
RESTAURANTS

WHEREAS, the City of Urbana has entered into an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Champaign-Urbana Health District which provides for the Champaign-Urbana Health District to issue restaurant licenses, which are required by the City, simultaneously with the issuance of a Health District permit and in furtherance thereof,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE URBANA CITY COUNCIL as follows:

Section 1. Section 11-1 of Chapter 11 and all of the existing Chapter 9 of the Urbana City Code are hereby repealed upon the taking effect of this Ordinance.

Section 2. The following new sections to Chapter 9 of the Urbana City Code are hereby enacted:

"Sec. 9-1. The Health Officer of the Champaign-Urbana Health District is hereby authorized to enforce all statutes, ordinances, and regulations to the extent applicable, pertaining to the preservation of health of the people of Urbana.

Sec. 9-2. Compliance. Every person operating a food service establishment which requires a permit from the Champaign-Urbana Health District shall, as a condition of the continuing vitality of the city restaurant license, at all times fully comply with all rules, regulations and orders of the State Department of Public Health and the Champaign-Urbana Health District, and all laws of the State of Illinois pertaining to the preservation of health. Failure to fully comply with all such rules, regulations and orders shall be cause for the suspension or revocation of the license issued by the City.

Sec. 9-3. Health District Permit Prerequisite. "No person shall operate a food service establishment anywhere in the City of Urbana if the operation of such food service establishment requires a health permit issued by the Champaign-Urbana Health District, without first so securing the health permit so required and a license from the City of Urbana to do so, and shall pay the fee set forth in Section 14-7 of the Urbana City Code. If any of the activities that would require a license also require the issuance of a health permit by the Champaign-Urbana Health District, then such license shall be issued by the Champaign-Urbana Health District if there is in existence an agreement between the City of Urbana and the

Champaign-Urbana Health District for the issuance of such license and if no such agreement exists at the time of application, then the City of Urbana shall issue such license in accordance with this Chapter.

Sec. 9-4. Automatic Revocation/Suspension. If the health permit of an establishment is revoked or suspended by action of the Health District, such act shall constitute grounds for the City to take the appropriate steps to revoke or suspend any food service establishment license issued by the City for such establishment and such revocation or suspension shall continue for the same period of time as the suspension or revocation of the Health District permit."

Section 3. Effective as to the first application or renewal of a Food Handling License by the City after the effective date of this Ordinance, the fees therefore shall be as follows:

1. Food handling establishment where food is prepared or sold at retail at a fixed location which is owned or rented by the establishment so licensed \$ 50.00
2. Food handling mobile dispenser/per unit \$ 35.00  
(a vehicle used for the delivery of food only does not require a license)

Section 4. The Comptroller is authorized to prorate fees to accommodate any mid-year changeover due to an agreement with the Champaign-Urbana Health District to issue food handling licenses on behalf of the City.

Section 5. If food handling licenses are issued by the Champaign-Urbana Health District on behalf of the City, then the license year of the City license shall be the same as the license year of the respective Champaign-Urbana Health District permit issued for such establishment.

Section 6. The City Clerk is directed to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form by authority of the corporate authorities, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect on the date indicated in Section 7 below, in accordance with Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.

Section 7. This ordinance shall be effective on the 1st day of February, 1996.

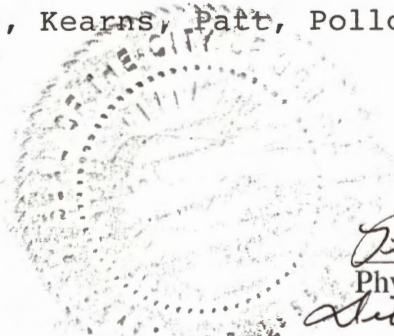
