#### **ORDINANCE NO. 9697-23**

## AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AN AMENDMENT TO THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS

## (The Northwest Corner of Bradley and Lincoln Avenues from Industrial to Medium Density Residential and Commercial - Plan Case #1627-CP-96)

WHEREAS, after due publication, a public hearing was held by the Urbana Plan Commission on July 18, 1996 concerning the Petition filed by Integroup, Inc. in Plan Case #1627-CP-96, to amend the City of Urbana's Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Urbana Plan Commission has forwarded the case to the Urbana City Council with a recommendation to approve the request so that the property herein described below and commonly known as the Tawney Tract will be designated from Commercial to Medium Density Residential; and,

WHEREAS, the requested Comprehensive Plan Amendment conforms to the goals and objectives of the City of Urbana's Comprehensive Plan, as amended; and

WHEREAS, the Urbana City Council has determined it is in the best interests of the citizens of the City of Urbana to amend the Comprehensive Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, THAT:

<u>Section 1.</u> The petitioner's request to designate the following described area commonly known as part of the northwest corner of Bradley and Lincoln Avenues to Medium-Density Residential is hereby approved:

Commencing at the south east corner of the south east 1/4 of Section 6, Township 19 North, Range 9 East of the Third Principal Meridian, Urbana, Champaign County, Illinois, thence north along the east line of the south east 1/4 of said section 6, a distance of 40.00 feet to the easterly extension of the north right-of-way line of Bradley Avenue; thence west along the easterly extension of the north right-of-way line of said Bradley Avenue, a distance of 33.00 feet to the intersection of the north right-of-way line of said Bradley Avenue as recorded in Book 1077 on page 448 in the records of the Champaign County Recorder's Office and the west right-of-way line of Lincoln Avenues as recorded in Book 661 on Page 497 in the records of the Champaign County Recorder's's Office for the point of beginning; thence west along the north right-of-way line of said Bradley Avenue, a distance of 1,266.43 feet to the east right-of-way line of Goodwin Avenue as recorded in Book 907 on page 542 in the records of the Champaign County Recorder's Office; thence north along the east right-of-way line of said Goodwin Avenue, a distance of 1,204.53 feet to the south west corner of the
