ORDINANCE NO. 9697-45

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SCHEDULE J OF SECTION 14-3 OF THE URBANA LOCAL TRAFFIC CODE PROHIBITING PARKING ON CERTAIN STREETS (CRYSTAL LAKE DR., RACE ST., MAIN ST.)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1. That Schedule J of §14-3, entitled "Parking Prohibited at All Times on Certain Streets", of Article XIV of the Urbana Local Traffic Code, is hereby amended by adding to that schedule, under the heading, "No Parking Either Side" the following portion of a street where no person shall park a vehicle:

Crystal Lake Drive

From Cunningham Av. to Maple St.

Section 2. That Schedule J of §14-3, entitled "Parking Prohibited at All Times on Certain Streets", of Article XIV of the Urbana Local Traffic Code, is hereby amended by deleting the language shown in strikeout type and adding the underlined language, under the heading, "No Parking This Side of Street" as follows:

Race Northbound From Michigan to 85 feet

East

past Michigan

From the centerline of Michigan

to 105' north of the centerline of Michigan

Main Eastbound

From Vine to Grove

South

Section 3. All ordinances, resolutions, motions, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall not be construed to affect any suit or proceeding pending in any court, or any rights acquired, or a liability incurred, or any cause or causes of action acquired or existing prior to the effective date of this Ordinance; nor shall any right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired, or affected by this Ordinance.

Section 5. The City Clerk is directed to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form by authority of the corporate authorities, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.
