

ORDINANCE NO. 9697-118

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE URBANA LIQUOR CODE (CLOSING HOUR)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS,  
AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION ONE:**

Section 3.3 of the Code of Ordinances shall be amended to read as follows,  
with the underlined language to be added, and the highlighted language to be deleted:

**Sec. 3-3. Hours of operation.**

(a) Except as prohibited elsewhere in this chapter, or by law, alcoholic liquor may be sold, offered for sale, or otherwise transferred with or without consideration at any time, except as follows:

(1) Monday through Saturday, between the hours of 1:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m.;

(2) Sunday, between the hours of 1:00 a.m. and 12:00 noon;

(3) When January first shall fall on a day other than Sunday, alcoholic liquor may be sold or offered for sale at any time except between the hours of 2:00 a.m. through 6:00 a.m.;

(4) When January first shall fall on a Sunday, alcoholic liquor may be sold or offered for sale at any time except between the hours of 2:00 a.m. until 12:00 noon.

(b) All times referred to herein shall be local time.

(c) The premises of each license where liquor is sold or offered for sale for consumption on the premises must be vacated within one hour after the closing hour at which sales of alcoholic liquor must stop, as required above except for the owner or manager and custodial personnel.

(d) Each licensee shall post in at least two (2) prominent places in the licensed premises, the hours of closing at which sales of alcoholic liquor must stop and the hours by which the premises must be vacated by all unauthorized persons.

**SECTION TWO:**

All ordinances, resolutions, motions, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

**SECTION THREE:**

This Ordinance shall not be construed to affect any suit or proceeding pending in any court, or any rights acquired, or a liability incurred, or any cause or causes of action acquired or existing prior to the effective date of this Ordinance; nor shall any right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired, or affected by this Ordinance.

**SECTION FOUR:**

The City Clerk is directed to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form by authority of the corporate authorities, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.

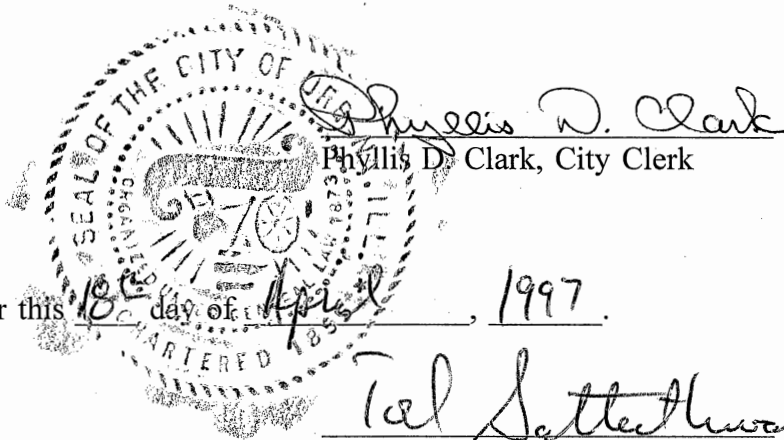

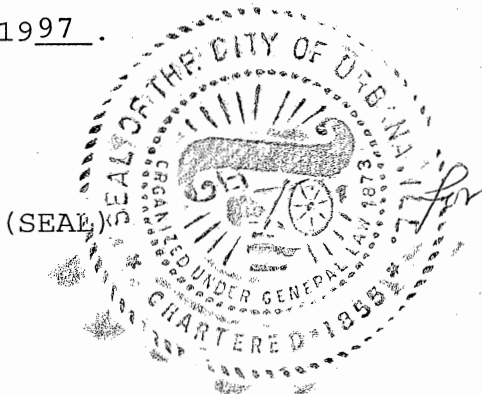
I, PHYLLIS D. CLARK, certify that I am the duly elected and acting Municipal Clerk of the City of Urbana, Champaign County, Illinois.
