

ORDINANCE NO. 9697-123

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE URBANA LOCAL TRAFFIC CODE; INTEGRATING THE PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER 23 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, "TRAFFIC AND MOTOR VEHICLES," WITH THE URBANA LOCAL TRAFFIC CODE; RECODIFYING THE URBANA LOCAL TRAFFIC CODE AS CHAPTER 23 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES; REPEALING THE EXISTING CHATER 23; AMENDING SCHEDULES OF FINES AND FEES; AND AMENDING SECTION 1-10 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1.

(A) That the URBANA LOCAL TRAFFIC CODE is amended, and that the new language of the Urbana Local Traffic Code shall be as set forth in the materials entitled, "CHAPTER 23 URBANA LOCAL TRAFFIC CODE" attached to this ordinance and incorporated into this ordinance by reference.

(B) That the URBANA LOCAL TRAFFIC CODE, as amended, is recodified as Chapter 23 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Urbana.

(C) That the existing provisions of Chapter 23, "TRAFFIC AND MOTOR VEHICLES" of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Urbana, consisting of "Article I. In General;" "Article II. Bicycles;" and "Article III. Parades" are repealed upon the effective date of the amendments and recodification of the Urbana Local Traffic Code.

Section 2.

That section 1-10 of the Code of Ordinances is amended to add the following underlined language:

§ 1-10(j) Urbana Local Traffic Code fines.

(1) Schedule of fines for certain specified offenses.

The fines for certain specified violations of the Urbana Local Traffic Code (Chapter 23 of this Code) shall be as established and amended from time to time by Ordinance in a separate schedule of fines. The schedule of fines shall be in effect until amended by a duly enacted ordinance of the City.

The schedule of fines shall be maintained by the Office of the Urbana City Clerk, and shall be made available for public inspection and copying.

(2) Pay-by-mail.

Certain violations of the Urbana Local Traffic Code may also be subject to Chapter 1, Sections 1-17 and 1-18, "Settlement of violations

prior to suit being filed; minimum fines."

(3) Fines in Judicial Proceedings for parking violations.

Regarding violations of any provision of Articles XII, XIII, and XIV, or § 23-17-4 through § 23-17-10 of the Urbana Local Traffic Code (Chapter 23 of this Code), if the violator has taken no steps to challenge the applicable fines as set forth in the schedule of fines, through the administrative process established in § 23-16-1 through § 23-16-4, and the City elects to obtain judgment of this violation in the Circuit Court, a maximum fine of two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00) for each violation may be imposed.

(4) In the event the City elects to initiate enforcement proceedings in the Circuit Court for any violation of the Urbana Local Traffic Code (Chapter 23 of this Code) the maximum fine for any violation shall be two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00), unless a higher maximum is set forth in the schedule of fines, in which case the maximum fine shall be the amount set forth in the schedule.

Section 3.

That Section 1-18 of the Code of Ordinances, "Minimum fine schedule for certain violations" is amended to delete the following language shown in ~~strikeout~~ print and to add the underlined language, and to place the retained language in the following sequence:

Section 4.

That the schedule of fines is amended to include the language set forth in the attached materials entitled "Urbana Local Traffic Code Fine Schedule", which is incorporated by reference into this ordinance.

Section 5.

That the schedule of fees maintained pursuant to § 14-7 of the Code of Ordinances is amended to include the language set forth in the attached materials entitled "Parking Meter Rates and Rental Space Rates", which is incorporated by reference into this ordinance.

Section 6. All ordinances, resolutions, motions, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

Section 7. This Ordinance shall not be construed to affect any suit or proceeding pending in any court, or any rights acquired, or a liability incurred, or any cause or causes of action acquired or existing prior to the effective date of this Ordinance; nor shall any right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired, or affected by this Ordinance.

Section 8. The City Clerk is directed to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form by authority of the corporate authorities, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council.

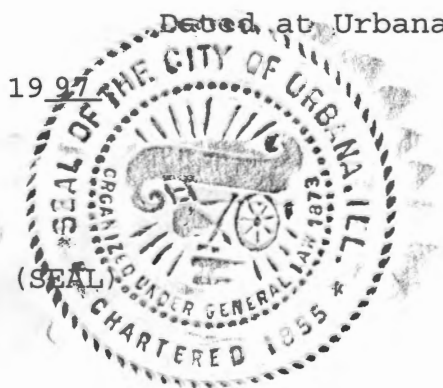
