ANNEXING CERTAIN TERRITORY
TO THE CITY OF URBANA

WHEREAS, the hereinafter described territory is situated in unincorporated territory adjacent to and contiguous to the City of Urbana, Illinois, and is part of the Edge Scott Fire Protection District and Philo Fire Protection District, and includes certain territory within the Urbana Township, and Notice was given to the Trustees of said Fire Protection Districts, the Board of Township Trustees, and the Township Commissioner of Highways, said notices being mailed on June 26, 1997, that this Ordinance would be voted upon at the regular meeting of this Council at 7:30 p.m., Monday, July 7, 1997, and the Affidavit of mailing such Notices was duly recorded with the Recorder of Deeds of Champaign County, Illinois, on the 3rd day of July, 1997; and

WHEREAS, a written petition signed by all of the owners of Record, of all land within such territory, has been filed with the City Clerk of the City of Urbana, Illinois, requesting annexation thereof to the City of Urbana; and

WHEREAS, there are no electors residing on the premises; and

WHEREAS, the City Council passed Ordinance No. 9697-87 on February 17, 1997 approving and authorizing the execution of an annexation agreement wherein the Corporate Authorities agreed to expeditiously annex said territory; and

WHEREAS, the territory to be annexed by this Ordinance is presently located within Champaign County's AG-2, Agriculture, R-1 Single Family Residence, R-3 Two Family Residence, and R-4 Multiple Family Residence zoning districts and upon annexation will be classified R-2 Single Family Residential, R-4 Medium Density Multiple Family Residential, R-5 Medium High Density Multiple Family Residential, and B-3 General Business upon annexation in accordance with the above-referenced annexation agreement; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that said petition complies with all requirements of the law therefore; and

WHEREAS, the majority of the Members of the Council are of the opinion that it would be for the best interests of the people of the City of Urbana, Illinois, that said territory be annexed to and made a part of the said City.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS:

Section 1. That the following described real estate, viz:

Tract 1: (Green Farm)

The West Half (W 1/2) of the Southeast Quarter (SE 1/4) and the East Half (E 1/2) of the Southwest Quarter (SW 1/4) of Section 22, Township 19 North, Range 9 East of the Third Principal Meridian, Champaign County, Illinois.

The above described tract being the same Tract described in Warranty Deed recorded in Deed Record Book 2337 at Page 0614, as Document Number 95R21328, in the Office of the Recorder, Champaign County, Illinois.

Except, Windsor Road Right-of-Way, being more particularly described as follows;

Windsor Road, formerly Illinois Route 130, right-of-way, being 50 feet in width, containing 3.03 Acres, more or less.

Said tract containing 158.07 Acres, more or less, all situated in Champaign County, Illinois.

Tract 2: (Noel Farm)

The East half of the Southeast Quarter of Section 22, Township 19 North, Range 9 East of the Third Principal Meridian, Champaign County, Illinois, except that part of the land conveyed to the State of Illinois by documents 86R857 and 86R858, and except that part of the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter of Section 22 lying South of the Abandoned Norfolk & Western Railroad.

The above described tract being the same Tract described in Warranty Deed recorded in Deed Record Book 2488 at Page 0650, as Document Number 97R02560, in the Office of the Recorder, Champaign County, Illinois.

Said tract containing 66.34 Acres, more or less, all situated in Champaign County, Illinois.

Tract 3: (Miller Farm)

All of the Northwest Quarter of Section 22, and the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 22, also, that portion of the Northeast Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 21 lying north of the abandoned Norfolk & Western Railroad; all in Township 19 North, Range 9 East of the Third Principal Meridian, Champaign County, Illinois.

The above described tract being part of a Tract described in Warranty Deed recorded in Deed Record Book 2403 at Page 0791, as Document Number 96R11842, in the Office of

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the Recorder, Champaign County, Illinois. Said tract containing 206.80 Acres, more or less, all situated in Champaign County, Illinois.

Tract 4: (Miller 19' Strip)

A tract of land being part of the Southwest Quarter of Section 15 and the Southeast Quarter of Section 16, all in Township 19 North, Range 9 East of the Third Principal Meridian, Champaign County, Illinois, the boundary of which is described as follows:

Beginning at the Southeast corner of said Southeast Quarter of Section 16, proceed South 89°-45'-13" West along the South line of said Southwest Quarter, 715.04 feet to the Northerly Right-of-Way line of the Norfolk and Southern Railroad (now abandoned); thence North 47°-35'-45" West along said Northerly Right-of-Way line, 11.62 feet to the Southwest corner of Lot 14 in Weller's Lincolnwood Third Section, a Subdivision in Champaign County, Illinois; thence North 88°-52'-10" East along the South line of said Weller's Lincolnwood Third Section, a Subdivision in Champaign County, Illinois and along the South line of Urbana-Scott's Subdivision, Champaign County, Illinois, 723.44 feet to the Southeast corner of Lot 2 in said Urbana-Scott's Subdivision, said point being on the East line of said Southeast Quarter of Section 16 and being 19.04 feet North of said Southeast corner of the Southeast Quarter of Section 16; thence North 89°-08'-28" East along the South line of a tract of land described in a warranty deed recorded in Book 768 at page 371 in the Champaign County Recorder's Office, 1322.74 feet to the East line of the West One-Half of said Southwest Quarter of Section 15; thence South 00°-43'-26" East along said East line of the West One-Half of the Southwest Quarter, 19.04 feet to the Southeast corner of said West One-Half of the Southwest Quarter; thence South 89°-08'-28" West along the south line of said West One-Half of the Southwest Quarter, 1322.67 feet to the Point of Beginning.

The above described tract being part of a Tract described in Warranty Deed recorded in Deed Record Book 2403 at Page 0791, as Document Number 96R11842, in the Office of the Recorder, Champaign County, Illinois. Said tract containing 1.38 Acres, more or less, all situated in Champaign County, Illinois.

Together with the following described adjacent public Rights-of-Way which are by operation of law automatically annexed with the adoption of an Annexation Ordinance pertaining to this parcel:

That portion of Windsor Road (formerly Philo Road and formerly Illinois Route 130) Right-of-Way, being 83.00 to 150.00 feet in width, which lies adjacent to the above described tract
and,

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That portion of High Cross Road (Illinois Route 130) Right-of-Way, being 130.00 to 220.00 feet in width which lies adjacent to the above described tract.

The above described Rights-of-Way containing 17.38 Acres, more or less, all situated in Champaign County, Illinois.

commonly known for reference as Stone Creek Subdivision, Urbana, Illinois, be and the same is hereby annexed to the City of Urbana, Illinois. The above-described parcels, prior to annexation, have the parcel index numbers 30-21-22-100-001, 30-21-22-100-002, 30-21-21-200-012, 30-21-22-400-004, and 30-21-22-400-006, and following annexation the said parcels should bear the parcel index numbers 93-21-22-100-001, 93-21-22-100-002, 93-21-21-200-012, 93-21-22-400-004, and 93-21-22-400-006, respectively.

Section 2. That the City Clerk be authorized and directed to record a certified copy of this Ordinance together with an accurate map of the territory hereinabove described in the Recorder's Office of Champaign County, Illinois.

Section 3. That the City Clerk be authorized and directed to file, for record, a certified copy of this Ordinance together with an accurate map of the territory hereinabove described in the Office of the County Clerk and County Election Authority of Champaign County, Illinois.

Section 4. The Zoning Ordinance of the City of Urbana, Illinois, and the Zoning Map of Urbana, Illinois, are hereby amended to classify the real property herein annexed as R-2 Single Family Residential, R-4 Medium Density Multiple Family Residential, R-5 Medium High

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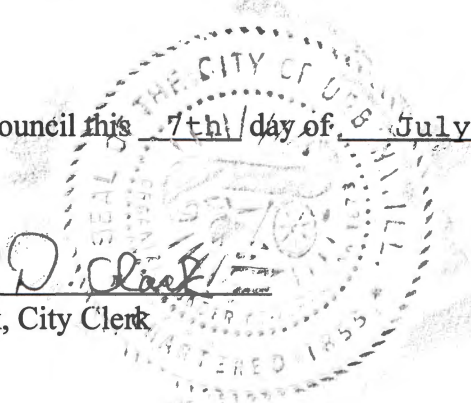
Density Multiple Family Residential, and B-3 General Business upon annexation and in accordance with an annexation agreement approved and authorized on February 17, 1997 by Council Ordinance No. 9697-87.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from after its passage and recording as provided by law.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council on the 7th day of July, 1997, A.D.
