

ORDINANCE NO. 9798-76

AN ORDINANCE RESPECTING VEHICLES PARKED ON PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY WITH EXPIRED REGISTRATION PLATES OR NO REGISTRATION PLATES

WHEREAS, the Illinois Vehicle Code in Section 11-208 thereof authorizes cities to regulate the parking and standing of vehicles; and

WHEREAS, Section 5/11-60-2 of the Illinois Municipal Code authorizes the corporate authorities of each municipality to define, prevent and abate nuisances; and

WHEREAS, the Urbana City Council finds that many of our streets in the City of Urbana were platted many years ago and are really too narrow to accommodate parking demands, and the Urbana City Council further finds that the increase in the ownership of automobiles has increased the parking congestion on the streets of the City, and the Urbana City Council further finds that the use of City streets for long-term storage of automobiles interferes with the use of streets for their intended purpose, and has become a nuisance, and further the Council finds that many such cars that are being stored in the long term are in fact automobiles with expired registration plates or no registration plates.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED THAT:

Section 1. Any motor vehicle which would be required to have motor vehicle registration plates under the laws of the State of Illinois to be operated upon the public highways, must have registration plates issued by the State of Illinois or another state which are valid and unexpired at all times when such vehicle is on a public street in the City of Urbana.

Section 2. That a vehicle found upon a public street in the City of Urbana in violation of this Ordinance shall subject the owner thereof to a fine of not less than Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) or each day that such vehicle remains in violation of this Ordinance.

Section 3. The City Clerk is directed to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form by authority of the corporate authorities, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.

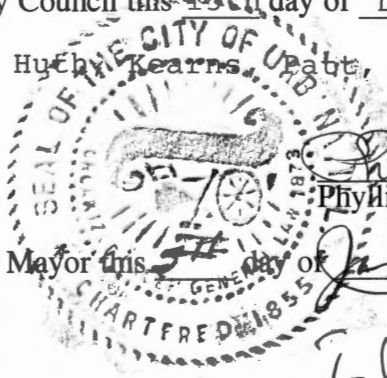
