

ORDINANCE NO. 9798-130

AN ORDINANCE FURTHER AMENDING CHAPTER FOURTEEN OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES REGARDING SCHEDULE OF FEES

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 9798-103 was passed on the 18th day of May, 1998, which said Ordinance approved the Schedule of Fees attached thereto, such fees to be effective on July 1, 1998; and

WHEREAS, subsequent to the passage of Ordinance No. 9798-103, two matters have come to the attention of the City staff which require further amendments to the said Schedule of Fees,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE URBANA CITY COUNCIL as follows:

Section 1. That that portion of the Schedule of Fees appearing on page 12 thereof, under the words "Fees for all other work", the following language is hereby repealed:

Electrical work shall be assessed at the rate of two percent (.02 multiplier) of the estimated or contract cost of the job; all amounts exceeding fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00) shall be assessed at the rate of one half of one percent (.005 multiplier) of the estimated or contract cost of the job."

and is replaced by the following language which is herein enacted:

Electrical work shall be assessed at the rate of one percent (.01 multiplier) of the estimated or contract cost of the job; all amounts exceeding fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00) shall be assessed at the rate of one half of one percent (.005 multiplier) of the estimated or contract cost of the job."

Section 2. That the following words are hereby deleted from paragraph (a) appearing under "Parking Meter Rates" on page 17:

"on California and Oregon Avenues between Lincoln Avenue and Gregory Street and those parking meters".


This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council.


