

ORDINANCE NO. 9899-14

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT FOR  
POLICE AND FIRE PROTECTION ASSISTANCE  
(U.S. National Hot Air Balloon Championships)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA,

AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT  
FOR POLICE AND FIRE PROTECTION ASSISTANCE

THIS INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT FOR POLICE AND FIRE PROTECTION ASSISTANCE, including any exhibit attached hereto (collectively, this "Agreement"), is made and entered into as of June 1, 1998, but actually executed by each of the undersigned municipalities on the dates set forth beneath the respective signatures of their duly authorized officers below, by and between the Village of Rantoul, Champaign County, Illinois (the "Village") and the City of Urbana, Champaign County, Illinois (the "City").

W I T N E S S E T H:

WHEREAS, the Village and the City are each a home rule unit of local government under and pursuant to Section 6 of Article VII of the Constitution of the State of Illinois and have the authority to exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to their government and affairs including, but not limited to, the power to regulate for the protection of the public health, safety, morals and welfare; and

WHEREAS, under and pursuant to Sections 1-4-6 and 11-1-2.1 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/1-4-6 and 5/11-1-2.1), the Village and the City are authorized to enter into agreements with each other to furnish police assistance on request; and

WHEREAS, under and pursuant to Section 11-6-1 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/11-6-1), the Village and the City are authorized to enter into contracts or agreements with each other for mutual aid consisting of furnishing personnel and equipment from and to each other for the prevention and extinguishment of fires; and

WHEREAS, Section 10 of Article VII of the Constitution of the State of Illinois and the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act (5 ILCS 220/1 et seq.) provide further authority for the Village and the City to obtain or share services and to exercise, combine or transfer any power or function not prohibited by law or ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Village requires and has requested the City to furnish certain police and fire protection assistance to the Village as more specifically identified in Exhibit A attached hereto and made a part hereof (the "Requested Assistance") in connection with the U.S. National Hot Air Balloon Championships to be held at the Rantoul National Aviation Center within the Village (the "Special Event") from August 7 to and including August 15, 1998 (the "Special Event Dates"); and



WHEREAS, the City is willing to provide the Requested Assistance to the Village for the Special Event on the Special Event Dates under and pursuant to terms and conditions of this Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the matters set forth above, the agreements, covenants, representations and undertakings made and contained in this Agreement, and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the Village and the City hereby agree, covenant, represent and undertake as follows:

## ARTICLE I In General

Section 1.1. General Definitions. Unless the context hereof clearly indicates otherwise, the capitalized words, terms and phrases defined in the recitals and preambles hereto and elsewhere herein shall have the same meanings for all purposes of this Agreement. In addition, in all cases the singular includes the plural, the plural includes the singular and a reference to any gender includes both genders and the neuter, as the case may be.

Section 1.2. Certain Phrases. The words "hereof", "herein", "hereunder", "hereto" and other words of similar import refer to this Agreement as a whole and not solely to the particular portion thereof in which any such word is used.

Section 1.3. Subdivisions. References to sections and other subdivisions of this Agreement are to the designated sections and other subdivisions of this Agreement as originally executed.

Section 1.4. Headings. The headings of this Agreement are for convenience of reference only and shall not define or limit the provisions hereof.

## ARTICLE II Police and Fire Protection Assistance

Section 2.1. Authority, Powers. (a) The Village hereby requests from the City and the City hereby agrees to provide to the Village the Requested Services for the Special Event by directing its Chief of Police and its Fire Chief, subject to the occurrence of any emergency requiring the presence of any such police officers or firefighters in the City and the requirements, if any, of any applicable collective bargaining agreement restricting or limiting the ability of the City to make any provision thereof, to make the necessary number of police officers and firefighters available to the Village for such purposes on each of the Special Event Dates.



(b) For and during any period that any such police officers of the City are performing the Requested Services for the Special Event on the Special Event Dates, such police officers of the City shall be under the authority and direction of the Chief of Police of the Village (or his designee) and shall have all of the powers of police officers of the Village. The Village shall brief any such police officers of the City on any applicable Village ordinances for the exercise of any such powers by police officers of the City for the Special Event. For and during any period that such firefighters of the City are performing the Requested Services for the Special Event on the Special Event Dates, such firefighters of the City shall be under the authority and direction of the Fire Chief of the Village (or his designee).

Section 2.2. Reimbursement. The Village hereby agrees to reimburse the City for any wages actually paid to police officers and firefighters of the City in connection with providing the Requested Services for the Special Event on the Special Event Dates, including for any subsequent court time of any such police officers required by the Village for the purposes of prosecution, such reimbursement to be made in accordance with the hourly rate schedule for the police officers and firefighters of the City as set forth in Exhibit B attached hereto and made a part hereof (the "Hourly Rates"). At any time after the Special Event Dates, the City shall submit a request for such reimbursement from the Village. Such request shall detail by date the actual number of hours for which any such police officers and firefighters of the City were furnished by the City to the Village on such date, together with the total amount to be reimbursed for each such date at the applicable Hourly Rates. Upon the receipt of any such request for reimbursement from the City, the Village shall pay such total reimbursable amount for all such Special Event Dates to the City within forty-five (45) days after receipt by the Village of such request.

Section 2.3. Other Liabilities. Except as otherwise provided in Section 2.2 of this Agreement, the City shall be solely responsible for any and all liability, obligation to indemnify imposed by law, employee benefits, wage and disability payments, pension and workers' compensation claims, damages to or destruction of equipment and clothing, and any medical expense of the City arising out of or in connection with furnishing the Requested Services for the Special Event on the Special Event Dates under this Agreement.

### **ARTICLE III**

#### **Miscellaneous**

Section 3.1. Notices and Communications. All notices, demands, requests for reimbursement or other communications under or in respect of this Agreement shall be in writing and shall be deemed to have been given when the same are (i) deposited in the

United States mail and sent by first class mail, postage prepaid or (ii) delivered, in each case, to the Village and the City at their respective addresses (or at such other address as each may designate by notice to the other), as follows:

(1) if to the Village, at the Village of Rantoul, Municipal Building, 333 South Tanner Street, Rantoul, Illinois 61866, Attn: Village President; and

(2) if to the City, at 400 South Vine Street, Urbana, Illinois 61801, Attn: Administrative Officer.

Whenever any party hereto is required to deliver notices, certificates, opinions, statements or other information hereunder, such party shall do so in such number of copies as shall be reasonably specified.

Section 3.2. Illinois Law. This Agreement shall be deemed to be an intergovernmental agreement made under and shall be construed in accordance with and governed by the laws of the State of Illinois.

Section 3.3. Written Modification. Neither this Agreement nor any provisions hereof may be changed, revised, modified, waived, discharged, terminated or otherwise abrogated, diminished or impaired other than by an instrument in writing duly authorized and executed by both the Village and the City.

Section 3.4. Counterparts. This Agreement may be signed in any number of counterparts with the same effect as if the signatures thereto and hereto were upon the same instrument.

Section 3.5. Effective Date and Term. This Agreement shall become effective upon its execution and delivery by both the Village and the City and shall be and remain in full force and effect thereafter for each of the Special Event Dates.

Section 3.6. Entire Agreement. This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement of the Village and the City on the subject matter hereof. The City represents, warrants, covenants and agrees that no representation, warranty, covenant or agreement shall be binding on the Village unless expressed in writing herein or by written modification pursuant to Section 3.3 hereof.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Village and the City have each caused this Agreement to be executed by proper officers duly authorized to execute the same as of the date set forth beneath the signatures of their respective officers set forth below.
