## ORDINANCE NO. **9899-15**

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 20-68 OF THE URBANA CITY CODE REGARDING BRICK SIDEWALKS

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE URBANA CITY COUNCIL as follows:

Section 1. The last paragraph of Section 20-68(a) will be deleted. A new paragraph (b) will be added as follows:

- "(b) Notwithstanding the restrictions set forth in this Section concerning the retention of brick sidewalks,
  - (1) those sections of brick sidewalk which are within the latest version of the Campus Master Plan of the University of Illinois, as adopted by the Board of Trustees, current as of April, 1996, may be replaced by the University of Illinois with concrete sidewalks, in conformity with Section 20-30 of this Code;
  - (2) those sections of brick sidewalk need not be retained where the City Council finds that due to changes in the vicinity of a specific request for waiver, the brick sidewalks no longer serve as an enhancement. In such cases a waiver may be granted by motion passed by a majority vote of all alderpersons then holding office.

Section 2. Current Sections 20-68(b) and (c) will be renumbered as Sections 20-68(c) and (d), respectively.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council.
