

ORDINANCE NO. 9899-19

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS OF THE URBANA CODE OF ORDINANCES
(Liquor Code)

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA,
ILLINOIS, that:

1. Section 3-43 of the Urbana City Code is amended to add paragraph (b) as follows:

"(b) Provided, however, if the limitation on the number of licenses authorized by the formula set forth in (a) above would preclude the issuance of liquor licenses as agreed in a written agreement approved by the City Council, additional liquor licenses shall be deemed to be automatically authorized in sufficient number to enable the City to honor the contractual commitment of the City.

2. Add the following sentence to Section 3-20:

"The term 'Restaurant' as used herein shall mean a public place maintained and held out to the public as a place where bona fide meals are actually and regularly served as one of the principal services of the business."

3. Section 3-42(c)(1) is amended to delete the last sentence thereof.

4. Section 3-41(a) is amended to read as follows:

"Class A Licenses shall permit the Licensee to sell at retail alcoholic liquors in package for consumption on or off the premises where sold, or by drink for consumption on the premises."


