## ORDINANCE NO. 9899-20

## AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE GRANT OF LICENSE RELATING TO HIGH STREET

WHEREAS, on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of June, 1998, this Council passed an Ordinance entitled "An Ordinance Granting a License to the University of Illinois to Perform Construction Work in the High Street Right-of-Way" (Ordinance No. 9798-122); and

WHEREAS, the said Ordinance required that, if the subject portion of High Street were not formally vacated by Council action prior to September 1, 1998, the University would restore the subject area to its former condition as public road right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, there is presently under consideration by the parties, an agreement to improve several streets and intersections in the campus area which agreement could impact the vacation of High Street as contemplated; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable and to the benefit of both parties to extend the September 1, 1998, date upon which the license was to automatically expire, to give the parties an opportunity to consider the said agreement,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED that Section 2 of Ordinance No. 9798-122 is hereby amended to provide the revocable license therein granted to the University of Illinois is extended to the 5th day of October, 1998, but in all other respects, the provisions of that Ordinance are hereby confirmed.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a two-thirds (2/3rds) majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of the said Council on the \_8th day of \_Sept.\_\_, 1998.
