## ORDINANCE NO. 9899-47

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 20-68 OF THE URBANA CITY CODE REGARDING BRICK SIDEWALKS

NOW THERFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE URBANA CITY COUNCIL as follows:

Section 20-68(b)(2) will be amended to read as follows:

"(2) those sections of brick sidewalk need not be retained where the City Council finds that due to changes in the vicinity of a specific request for waiver, the brick sidewalks no longer serve as an enhancement. In such cases a waiver may be granted by motion passed by a majority vote of all alderpersons then holding office.

The waiver may be conditioned upon the sidewalk being replaced with concrete dyed and stamped to resemble brick pavers in a manner and design acceptable to the Director of Public Works."

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council.
