#### **ORDINANCE NO.** <u>9899–48</u>

#### AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN TERRITORY TO THE CITY OF URBANA

#### (Miracle Water / 1302 N. Lincoln Avenue)

WHEREAS, the hereinafter described territory is situated in unincorporated territory adjacent to and contiguous to the City of Urbana, Illinois, and is part of the Eastern Prairie Fire Protection District, and includes certain territory within the Urbana Township, and Notice was given to the Trustees of said Fire Protection District, the Board of Township Trustees, and the Township Commissioner of Highways, said notices being mailed on <u>November 20</u>, 1998, that this Ordinance would be voted upon at a meeting of this Council at 7:30 p.m., Monday, <u>December 7</u>, 1998, and the Affidavit of mailing such Notice was duly recorded with the Recorder of Deeds of Champaign County, Illinois, on the <u>20th</u>day of <u>November</u>, 1998; and

WHEREAS, there are no electors residing within said territory; and

WHEREAS, the territory to be annexed by this Ordinance is presently located within Champaign County's R-4 Multiple Family Residential zoning district and upon annexation will automatically be classified R-4 Medium Density Multiple-Family Residential upon annexation in accordance with Article IV, Section IV-5 of the Urbana Zoning Ordinance; and

<u>Section 1</u>. That the following described real estate, viz:

<u>Section 3</u>. That the City Clerk be authorized and directed to file, for record, a certified copy of this Ordinance together with an accurate map of the territory hereinabove described in the Office of the County Clerk and County Election Authority of Champaign County, Illinois.

Section 4. The Zoning Ordinance of the City of Urbana, Illinois, and the Zoning Map of Urbana, Illinois, are hereby amended to classify the real property herein annexed as R-4 Medium Density Multiple-Family Residential upon annexation and in accordance with Article IV, Section IV-5 of the Urbana Zoning Ordinance.

Section 5. The territory annexed herein is assigned to City of Urbana Ward 3.

<u>Section 6</u>. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from after its passage and recording as provided by law.


