

ORDINANCE NO. 9899-50

AN ORDINANCE DELETING SECTION 23-145 OF THE URBANA LOCAL TRAFFIC CODE, ENTITLED "PERMITS FOR BICYCLES," AND ESTABLISHING A NEW SECTION 23-145 ENTITLED "REGISTRATION OF BICYCLES."

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF URBANA, ILLINOIS, as follows:

**Section 1.** That Section 23-145, entitled "Permits for Bicycles" of the Urbana Local Traffic Code as amended, is hereby deleted and replaced by a new Section 23-145 entitled "Registration of Bicycles" to read as follows, with the strikethrough language indicating deletions and the underlined language indicating new language:

**~~Sec. 23-145. Permits for bicycles.~~**

~~—— (a) No resident owner of a bicycle shall ride a bicycle or permit it to be ridden by others on any street unless such bicycle has been provided with the proper permit tag or plate as provided in this section.~~

~~—— (b) Application, fee.~~

~~—— (1) Application for a permit to own and operate a bicycle shall be made to the chief of police on a form provided by the city.~~

~~—— (2) The application shall be accompanied by a fee as set forth in section 14-7 of the Code of Ordinances and the schedule of fees to cover the cost of the permit tag or plate and the enforcement of this section. Such fee shall be payable to the city collector.~~

~~—— (c) The chief of police is hereby empowered to issue bicycle permits accompanied by a tag or plate. All such permits shall be dated when issued. The chief of police shall cause a record to be made of all permits issued.~~

~~—— (d) Permits under this section shall be good for as long as the same bicycle is owned by such permit holder.~~

~~—— (e) Upon issuance of a tag or plate under this section, it shall be affixed to the frame of the bicycle in such position as to be plainly visible. The removal of any plate or tag from such bicycle, except by proper authority or upon transfer of ownership, shall be a violation of this section.~~

~~— (f) Upon the sale or transfer of a registered bicycle, the holder of the permit shall surrender such permit to the chief of police or, with the approval of the chief of police, assign the permit to another bicycle owned by such person upon payment of a fee as set forth in Chapter 14, section 14-7, of the Code of Ordinances.~~

#### **Registration of Bicycles.**

- (a) Voluntary Registration. Bicycles owned or operated within the City may be registered with the Chief of Police. No registration or any kind of licensing of bicycles shall be required.
- (b) Authority. The Chief of Police shall provide for voluntary registration of bicycles. Registration shall be by serial number, make, model, and description, on a form provided by the City.
- (c) Fee. No fee shall be charged for registration of bicycles under this provision.

**Section 2.** The Schedule of fees maintained pursuant to Section 14-7 of the Code of Ordinances shall be amended to delete the fee that had been established for the permit requirement that this ordinance deletes.

**Section 3.** The City Clerk is directed to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form by authority of the corporate authorities, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.

This Ordinance is hereby passed by the affirmative vote, the "ayes" and "nays" being called, of a majority of the members of the Council of the City of Urbana, Illinois, at a regular meeting of said Council.
