AN ORDINANCE CHANGING A STREET NAME
(Smith Road)

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/11-80-19), the corporate authorities of each municipality may name originally and then may change the name of any street, avenue, alley, or other public place, such change to be effective as therein further provided and conditioned; and

WHEREAS, due to the changing of alignment of the frontage road, commonly known as Smith Road, that lies northwest of and parallel to Illinois 130 Urbana Spur, and the platting and construction of an easterly extension of Butzow Drive, and the platting and construction of Guardian Drive, the name of the frontage road is confusing; and

WHEREAS, the portion of Smith Road described below does not align with Smith Road south of Illinois 130 Urbana Spur, and portions have been re-constructed as extensions of Butzow Drive and Guardian Drive; and

WHEREAS, a portion of Smith Road to be renamed lies outside the Urbana City Limits; and, Champaign County has agreed to pass an Ordinance to rename said portion; and

WHEREAS, there is a desire to avoid confusion in locating of an existing manufacturing plant bearing the address of 601 North Guardian Drive, and it is deemed in the best interests of the City of Urbana to make the following street name changes.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE URBANA CITY COUNCIL as follows:

Section 1. That the following described public road is hereby changed from "Smith Road" to "Guardian Drive."

A road situated in the Southeast Quarter of Section 9, Township 19 North, Range 9 East of the Third Principal Meridian, further described as follows:

All that part of Smith Road (also known as the frontage road) from University Avenue (Illinois 130 and U.S. Route 150), North, approximately 200 feet, to its intersection with the southerly extension of Guardian Drive.

Situated in the City of Urbana, Champaign County, Illinois, as shown on the sketch attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Section 2. That the following described public road is hereby named “Guardian Drive.”

A road situated in the Southeast Quarter of Section 9, Township 19 North, Range 9 East of the Third Principal Meridian, further described as follows:

All that part of the southerly extension of Guardian Drive from the southern terminus of Guardian Drive as shown on Guardian West First Subdivision, City of Urbana, Champaign County, Illinois, South, approximately 120 feet, to its intersection with the frontage road known as Smith Road.

Situated in the City of Urbana, Champaign County, Illinois, as shown on the sketch attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Section 3. That the following described public road is hereby named “Butzow Drive.”

A road situated in the Southeast Quarter of Section 9, Township 19 North, Range 9 East of the Third Principal Meridian, further described as follows:

All that part of the easterly extension of Butzow Drive from the eastern terminus of Butzow Drive as shown on Guardian West First Subdivision, City of Urbana, Champaign County, Illinois, Southeastly, approximately 75 feet to the City Limit Line.

Situated in the City of Urbana, Champaign County, Illinois, as shown on the sketch attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Section 4. That certified copies of this Ordinance be delivered to the Champaign County

Clerk, the United States Postal Service branch office serving the area, and the District Engineer of the Illinois Department of Transportation in Paris, Illinois, by certified or registered mail.

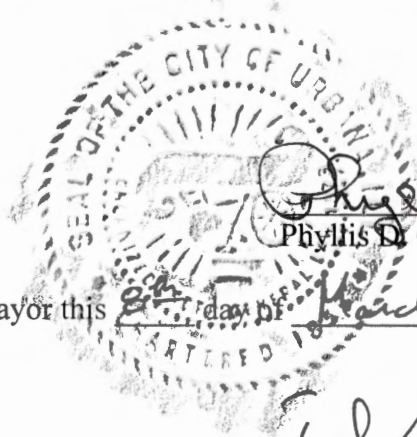
