

AN ORDINANCE REGARDING MISCELLANEOUS
AMENDMENTS TO THE LIQUOR CODE

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE URBANA CITY COUNCIL as follows:

Section 1. That subsection (b) of Section 3-40 entitled "Application" is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(b) Every license holder must, in the application for a liquor license (other than a T License) list up to three (3) persons who are designated as 'managers' and qualified to act on behalf of the licensee. An owner can also be a manager. One of such persons must be available to act (either in person or via telephone) on behalf of the licensee at all times. Such managers must not be disqualified to hold a liquor license in the State of Illinois other than for reasons of citizenship. Any person who is listed as a manager must reside in Champaign County, Illinois, or, if they reside outside of Champaign County, such person must be regularly present at the licensed premises for a minimum of thirty (30) hours each week. If any of the persons so designated as managers in the application are no longer serving in such capacity, the mayor must be advised in writing within five (5) days of the date when such person's duties as manager is terminated. Managers may be added during the license year provided the mayor approves application for such person."

Section 2. That Section 3-41(c) is repealed in its entirety.

Section 3. That a new subsection c of Section 3-41 is hereby enacted to read:

"(c) Additional Location Permits.

- (1) Class AA License holders have the option of being issued an additional location permit which shall authorize the sale of alcoholic liquors at an additional permanent location in the hotel or motel on the same terms and conditions as authorized in the Class AA License. However, no more than two such location permits shall be issued to any Class AA License holder. The charge for such Class AA location permits shall be as set forth in the Schedule of Fees.
- (2) Sidewalk Café Permits may be issued to any license holder of a Class A, AA, B or BB license ('main license') whose business establishment is primarily engaged in the sale and consumption of food on premises. If the additional fee for the sidewalk café permit, as set forth in section 14-7 of the city Code is paid to the city, the sidewalk café permit shall permit the sale only of beer and wine (or only beer if the main license is Class B) by the license holder within the area for which the licensee also holds a valid sidewalk café permit issued by the director of public works."

Section 4. Section 3-41 entitled "Classification" is amended to add the following new license entitled "GC (Golf Course)":

"(n) *Class GC License*, to be known as the Golf Course License can be issued only to the operator of a clubhouse located on a golf course, which golf course is comprised of 50 acres or more. A GC License shall permit the licensee to sell at retail alcoholic liquor for consumption within the clubhouse and any defined area adjacent thereto (as described in the application) or pavilion and to sell alcoholic liquor from mobile carts with the number of such mobile carts to be operated on the golf course limited to not more than four (4). In addition to such mobile carts, the licensee may sell alcoholic liquor at fixed refreshment stands at locations approved by the Mayor. The sale of alcoholic liquor on the golf course outside of the clubhouse and adjacent enclosed areas or pavilion shall be subject to any further conditions and regulations required by the Mayor to promote public safety and welfare.

Section 5. The City Clerk is directed to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form by authority of the corporate authorities, and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication in accordance with Section 1-2-4 of the Illinois Municipal Code.


