

Amendment 1. to City of Urbana – Village of Savoy Boundary Agreement


WHEREAS, the City of Urbana, a municipal corporation and home rule unit (hereinafter “Urbana”), and the Village of Savoy, Illinois, a municipal corporation (hereinafter “Savoy”) have entered into a Boundary Agreement on August 7, 1991 to establish a boundary for purposes of planning, zoning and annexation; and

WHEREAS, Urbana and Savoy are authorized by Article 7, Section 10, of the 1970 Constitution of the State of Illinois to contract or otherwise associate among themselves to exercise jointly any power or powers, privileges or authority exercised or which may be exercised by said municipality individually in any manner not prohibited by law; and

WHEREAS, the Boundary Agreement, previously agreed to, has created an area in which Urbana has the authority for planning, zoning and annexation purposes according to the agreement, and Savoy, by operation of state law, since the area is within one and one half miles at the corporate limits of Savoy, has the sole authority to approve subdivisions; and


WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of both municipalities to enter into this amendment to determine the processes of a subdivision in that area.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED this 7th day of June, 2000 by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Savoy that Village President Robert C. McCleary is hereby authorized to execute Amendment No. 1 to the City of Urbana – Village of Savoy Boundary Agreement as attached hereto.

ADDENDUM NO. 1 TO THE SAVOY-URBANA BOUNDARY AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, in 1990/1991 Urbana and Savoy entered into a Boundary Agreement (hereafter "Agreement"), which agreement established a line which recognized the boundary between Urbana and Savoy, on each side of which the respective city or village had the planning, zoning and annexation powers; and

WHEREAS, since 1991, due to growth of each of the municipalities, the extraterritorial jurisdiction of each has expanded to the point where the extraterritorial jurisdiction of each municipality extends into the area designated as the annexation area of the other municipality and in some instances, the extraterritorial jurisdictional lines actually overlap; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to clarify what was intended in the 1992 agreement was to have each municipality cede to the other all municipal powers relating to the control, not only of annexation, zoning and planning, but all matters relating to land development and subdivision control; and

WHEREAS, the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act encourages agreements such as this to promote efficiency in government.

NOW THEREFORE, FOR AND IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL UNDERTAKINGS HEREIN, the parties agree as follows:

1. That the City of Urbana reaffirms that it has ceded to the Village of Savoy all of its authority governing all matters relating to planning, subdivision, land development, and zoning, including the right to protest County Zoning actions, and annexations pertaining to all land which is in the area placed under the jurisdiction of the Village of Savoy pursuant to the Agreement; and

1. That the Village of Savoy reaffirms that it has ceded to the City of Urbana all of its authority governing all matters relating to planning, subdivision, land development, and zoning, including the right to protest County Zoning actions, and annexations pertaining to all land which is in the area placed under the jurisdiction of the City of Urbana pursuant to the Agreement.

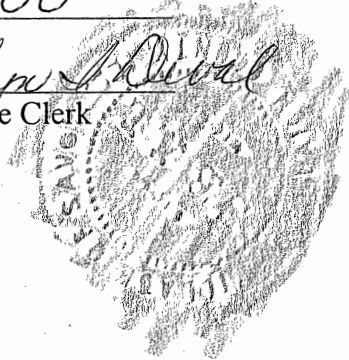
